

INTERESTING ITEMS OF NEWS FROM ALL OVER NEW MEXICO

The Red Copper Company, principal office at Organ, Dona Ana county, has been incorporated with a capitalization of \$500,000.

The Old Governor Mining and Smelting Company, principal office at Roswell, has been incorporated with a capital stock of \$1,000,000.

Conductor Edward Wigley of Las Vegas was brought from Bernalillo February 1st with one of his feet crushed off. He was thrown under an engine.

Judge W. H. Pope, sitting at Socorro, has granted bail to Irwin Wallace, who shot and killed W. M. McCammon, fixing the amount at \$10,000.

Arthur Sellman has been appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to go to New York and try to compromise with Coler & Co. the debt of Santa Fe county, which amounts to \$1,000,000.

After being a fugitive for several weeks, Antonio Archuleta has been arrested at Blanca, San Juan county, near the Colorado line, for the alleged murder of Lolores Sanchez, a gambler of Cerro, Taos county.

Two distinct earthquakes were felt at Socorro and San Rafael and places near the two towns on the night of January 23rd, causing four shocks within two weeks.

A Pueblo, Colorado, dispatch of February 6th says: Rev. Wm. H. Moore, pastor of the Santa Fe Presbyterian Church at Santa Fe, New Mexico, is probably the first man to go to the mines of Pueblo three weeks ago to be treated at Clark's mineral well.

Word was received recently of the death of Johnstone, Nebraska, of George W. Johnston, formerly an attorney at Albuquerque. After a struggle against the disease for a year, he died at his home at Booneville a year ago, accompanied by his wife and the Rev. J. L. Weaver.

The Albuquerque correspondent of the Denver Republican, under date of February 2d, says: For the last few weeks there were rumors in circulation of differences between President C. J. Ward and other officials of the American Lumber Company and General Manager John B. Bennett.

J. W. Benham, president of the Benham Indian Trading Company in Hills in Albuquerque recently said that the government had just decided to have a regular Indian reservation exhibit, with a model school in the highest development, with prize Indian students.

A Rowell dispatch of February 4th says: Hon. Joseph C. Lea, "the man who blazed the way in the Pecos valley," mayor of Rowell and member of the Board of Regents of the New Mexico Military Institute of Rowell, died today at noon.

EVENTS IN WASHINGTON AND TRANSACTIONS OF CONGRESS

One of the results of the debate in Congress on the departmental libraries is an order closing the fiction division of the War Department.

The House committee on Indian affairs authorized a favorable report upon the bill which has passed the Senate authorizing the secretary of the interior to grant rights of way for pipelines for conveyances of oil and gas through Indian reservations.

President Roosevelt has instructed the State and Navy Departments to take effective measures to secure preparation for the murder of an American in San Domingo and to bring about the best representation in the long-standing grievances of Americans in the West Indian republic.

Assistant Secretary of State Loomis transmitted to the House a memorial from the West Island Packing Company of New York praying for relief on the ground that the decision of the Alaska boundary tribunal placed the canning plant on the Canadian side.

General Sanchez, the newly-appointed Dominican minister, called at the State Department and left a note expressing regret for the killing of Johnston, the machinist, on the American States gunboat Yankee.

By unanimously agreeing to a resolution amending the act of February 2d, 1903, the resident commissioner to Congress from Porto Rico was given additional authority equal in all essential respects to that of a delegate from a territory.

A Carlsbad correspondent says that there will be nearly 2,000 acres of cotton planted in the vicinity of Carlsbad this spring.

Senator Teller recently received letters from Colorado and Wyoming citizens residing near the Colorado-Wyoming boundary.

The secretary of the interior has approved the setting aside of \$2,500,000 of the reclamation fund for the irrigation project along the Rio Grande.

The Senate committee on agriculture on the 6th inst. gave a hearing to Senator Teller's bill appropriating \$250,000 to conduct experiments to non-corn-growing states.

It is declared that western members of Congress who are working for statedhood for the territories are of opinion that the situation is acute and the territories are in a perilous position.

Complete investigation of the protests against Senator Reed Smoot retaining his seat in the United States Senate will begin March 1st before the committee on privileges and elections.

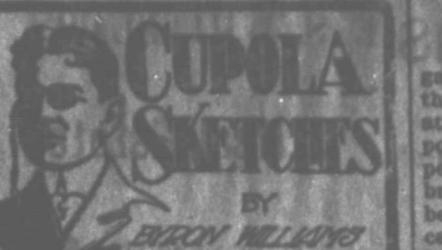
