## A NOTED TREE

St. Luke Sat Under it Two Thousand Years Ago

There are many venerable and famous trees in the world, and nearly every community has a specimen or two which it regards with special pride and veneration, but all these seem to be in the first fiush of youth when compared with the great planetree on the Island of Cos. in the Egean Sea.

This tree stands in the main street of the principal town, which also is called Cos. Under its branches tradition says both St. Luke and St Paul rested.
It is a huge tree, eighteen yards in circumference and over two thousand years old.

It is surrounded by a podium, or raised platform, breast-high, boubtless built to support the trunk of the tree after it had become hollow詴 weak from age.
The lower branches are still well by pieces of antigue columns, up the upper ends of which the over the upper ends of which the branches have grown like caps, in consequence of the pressure of their own weight. Close by the tree is a solid marble seat, which is said to have been the chair of Hippocrates, the Greek physician, called the "Father of Medicine," and it is supposed that he taught the art of healing from that seat. He was born at Cos. 640 B. C.

This gives a clew to the great age of the celebrated plane tree, which must he considerably more than two thousand years old. The Sultan hes given orders that the tree be very carefully guarded against the depre. dations of relic-hunters.
