T.S.T.A. Plon provides $\$ 45$ per month teacher raise. Local distriet would inc rease its local fund assignment only 7 per cent. Governor's plan provides $\$ 20.45$ per month raise yet would increase its local fund assignment approximately 12 per cent. Terrell County now has aight additional teachers over the maximum required by the state. What will be the situation if Governor Connally's bill passes? We will probably lose these treachers and your children will be placed in over-crowded classrooms. They will suroly lose many of the opportunities they now have. Good teachers will soon be looking for greener pastures.
