Bank Assets Register Gain; Deposits Reflect Increases

Rankin First State Bank registered a hefty jump over the figures in the financial statement released this week by the bank. On December 31 total assets were put at \$1.25 billion. In the current report, that amount had risen to \$1.44 billion.

Of this increase was registered in deposits which were up 15 percent last year and up to 20 percent for the present. Both time and savings deposits accounted for the increase.

The report, demand deposits were at \$2,259,451.60 and had a current figure of \$2.76 billion. A year ago, the time deposits were put at \$1.23 billion and are now \$2,440 million.

Profits were listed at \$3 million in the recent report, up from \$2.3 million a year ago. The bank had declared a dividend of \$12,500 as of December 31, 1972.

The average total deposits for the 15 calendar days ending January 13 had risen from \$1.37 billion a year ago to the mark of \$4,919,691.74, the bank reported. Loans were down. This year was put at \$1,993,813.17 in the report and was \$2,303 million last year at this time.

From Office of Tax Assessor-Collector --

Voters Alerted to New Rules on Current Registration Procedures

Gone are the simple old days when one paid his poll tax on or before January 31, got his receipt and was ready to go to the polls at any time.

Since those by-gone days, numerous "improvements" in voter registration have been made, both by the State and Federal governments. These changes never seem to be completed, and as a result, each year see new regulations and requirements handed down—some not very clear and some still unanswered.

Rankin Country Club to Elect Officers

Rankin Country Club has set Thursday, January 13 as the date for their Annual Meeting. Time is to be at 7:00 p.m. at the club house.

Among matters to be transacted will be the election of officers including president, vice-president, secretary and several directors. In addition, a financial report for 1971 will be given.

All club members are urged to attend this meeting.

In an effort to assist voters in qualifying themselves to cast a ballot in this, a "big" political year, the office of H. E. "Gene" Eckols, Sheriff, Tax Assessor-Collector this week made available some of the regulations.

For one thing, that old personal dog-tag — your Social Security number—now figures in on your voter registration. You must have your Social Security number. In addition, you will need your street address—P. O. boxes are not enough—and your telephone number if you have one.

If a voter should move, to a different precinct or another county, he should notify the Tax Office. The same goes for changing of name through marriage, etc. The voter should take his certificate to the office and these changes will be noted thereon.

As to deadlines, the best procedure would be for the voter to register as soon as possible; al-

Aubrey Edwards files for District Attorney

Aubrey Edwards, Big Lake attorney, has authorized the Rankin News to announce his candidacy for the office of District Attorney of the 83rd Judicial District. The district includes Brewster, Jeff Davis, Pecos, Presidio, Reagan and Upton Counties.

Edwards filed application for a place on the ballot in the upcoming May 6 Democratic Party election. He has been a practicing attorney in Big Lake for the past eight years, and has been a resident of Big Lake for 22 years. He is a graduate of Iraan High School, holds a BBA degree from Sul Ross State University and a law degree from Baylor University.

He married the former Cotter White of Alpine in 1941, and they have two sons, Dan, now serving in the U. S. Air Force, and Mark, a Big Lake Junior High School student.

"I pledge to devote my utmost effort to insuring that criminal dockets are kept current. When grand juries return indictments, they have the right to expect prompt disposition of the cases. This I will endeavor to provide, if elected," Edwards stated in his announcement for office this week,

though he might do so up until thirty-one days prior to the election. This could result in some confusion since a number of elections will be held this year with the earliest coming in April for city, school and hospital district boards and councils.

These requirements apply to all voters, ages 18 and up. No voter is any longer exempt from registration because of age.

And one final change, this one designed to eliminate waiting in line while your certificate is typed up. Using data-processing, in Upton County, certificates are to be mailed to voters in February. All that is necessary is that the voter supply the information listed above, sign the application blank and that's it. A husband, wife, father, mother, son or daughter may sign the application.

NO HARM DONE—

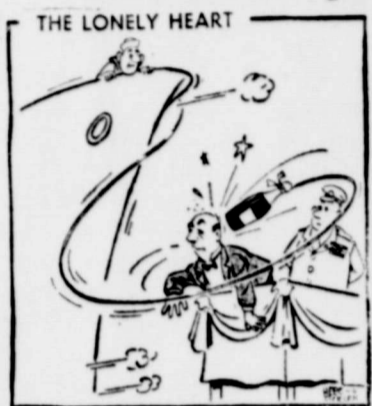

Register to vote **NOW** at the Tax Office in the courthouse in Rankin, or at the Sheriff's office at the Sub-Station in McCamey.

You will need to know your street address, telephone number and your Social Security number.

You will make application now and your certificate will be mailed to you in February. Upton County will be using the data-processing method.

If you change address, precinct or move to another county, you must notify your Tax Assessor-Collector. Take your certificate to the Tax Office so the changes can be made. If you change your name through marriage, etc., you should notify the Tax Office.

Register now, or be sure and do so thirty-one (31) days prior to an election to be eligible to vote.

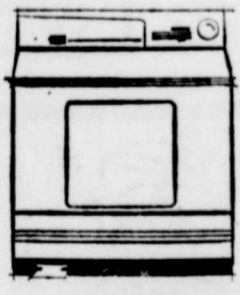

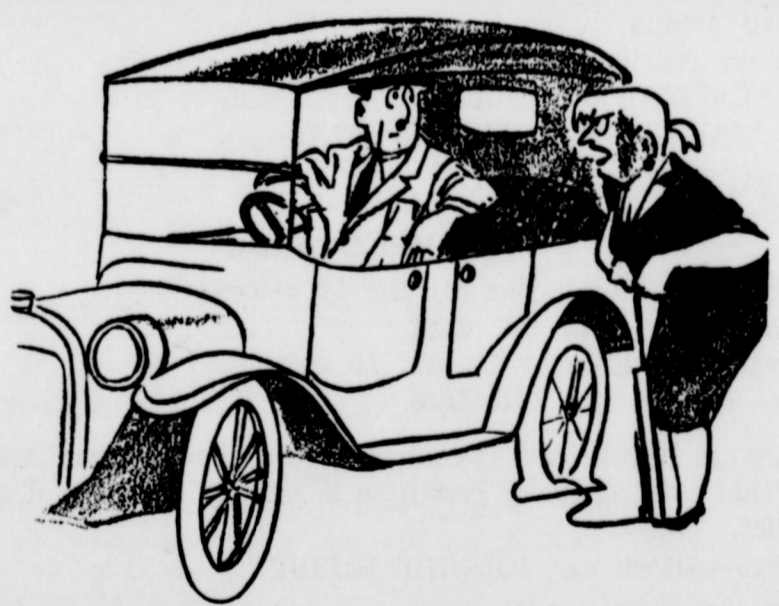

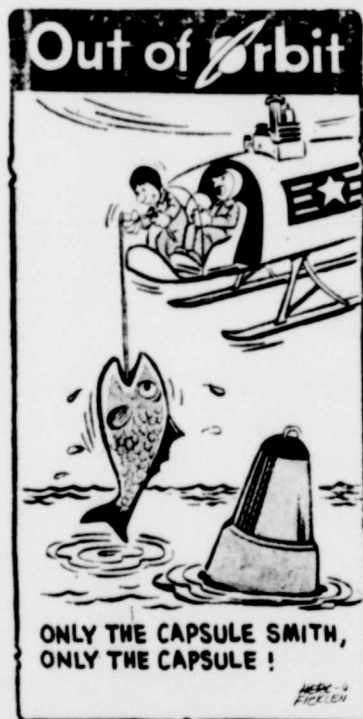
