SUDAN BASKETBALL FEMS WIN TOURNAMENT TROPHIES

The Sudan basketball teams won three trophies and placed two players on All-Tournament teams at the Sundown tournament. Kathy Minyard, guard for the Hornets, and Mike Bellar, outstanding Hornet player, were named to the All-Tournament teams.

The Hornettes won consolation trophy at the Sundown tournament by the Springlake B-team girls won second place trophy in Springlake, being defeated for first place by the Springlake, being defeated by the Springlake B-team girls. The eighth grade girls came home from Muleshoe with consolation trophy for the junior high tournament.

Seems the girls won the trophies although the boys played some good games. The varsity boys met Meadow Friday afternoon at Sundown where Meadow downed them 56-49. Meadow led 7 points at the half, 28-21. Coach Norman Nelson stated that the boys just couldn't find the basket and their defense wasn't quite up to par, letting the Meadow boys in to

score. Mike Bellar led Sudan scoring with 20 points, followed by Larry Morgan with 11 and Danny Martin with 9.

Going into the consolation bracket, Sudan faced Gail and were edged out by a 67-60 score. Gail took an early lead and led 41-24 at the half, although Sudan came back in the final quarter and narrowed the margin to 2 points when Gail went into a stall. Several fouls were called on the Hornets who were trying desperately to get possession of the ball, giving Gail the 7 point margin in free throws.

The B-team boys, did no better in Springlake tournament as Springlake freshmen defeated them 48-31 in their opening game with Pat Minyard scoring 9 for Suda. The Dimmitt B-team then downed the quintet from Sudan 26-15 to stop Sudan's chances for the consolation crown. Larry Hanna led Sudan in scoring with 8 points. Troy Chitty is coach for the B-team.

T. P. Wingo's eighth grade boys, missing two of their starting players, couldn't seem to get started in the Muleshoe tournament and were downed first, by Farwell, 55-14; then Priona, 57-14.

The girls lost their first game to Meadow Friday afternoon, 29-25, which was a hard fought game that went into overtime. The low score is evidence that the guards did a good job on defense, but the forwards couldn't seem to find the basket and only made 15 per cent of their free throws. Penny Mudgett scored 14 points and Donna Gaston 10.

Saturday morning they played Southland in the consolation bracket

and defeated them 45-40. It was a close game with Southland leading 17-15 at the half. Sudan went ahead in the final quarter by scoring 19 points. Sharon Baker led the Sudan scoring with 16 points, followed closely by Miss Mudgett with 15. The forwards upped their percentage of FT to 65 per cent.

The battle for the consolation crown was fought Saturday afternoon when the Hornets met the Bula girls in a very close game. Sudan took a 19-16 lead at the half and managed to hang onto it the last half, due largely to the fine defensive playing by the guards. Miss Baker again led the scoring with 14 points and Miss Mudgett scored 11.

The B-team girls, composed of Freshman and Sophomores, played the Springlake freshmen girls to open their tournament play Friday. Sudan won the game hands down with the final score 44-23, with Kathy Fisher scoring 24 points for Sudan.

Continuing their winning streak, the Sudan B-team defeated Priona B-team 32-31 in a breathless game with Miss Fisher scoring 15 points, Connie Lance and Sharon Wilson each had 7 points to aid in the Sudan scoring.

The Springlake B-team girls won the first place trophy from the Sudan girls in a very close game. Springlake took the lead in the fourth quarter and then went into a stall which caused the Sudan girls to foul, giving Springlake an edge in the final score of 44-32. Leading the scoring for Sudan were Miss Fisher with 15 points, and Miss Wilson with 11 points.

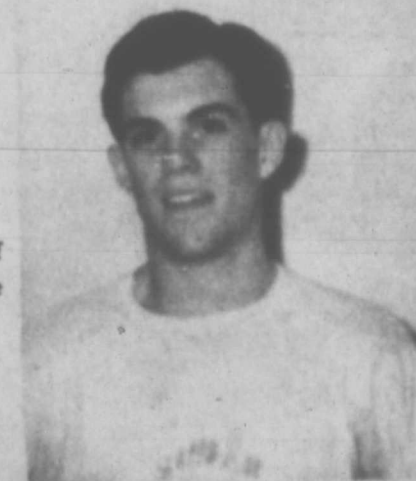
Like most of the games played by the Sudan fems, the eighth grade girls lost their first game in the Muleshoe tournament when Farwell scored in the last few seconds of the game which ended 19-18. Farwell led 10-7 at the half and Sudan came back in the fourth period to take a narrow lead only to be shut out by one point. Donna Hill led the scoring for Sudan with 10 points.

Sudan then defeated the Muleshoe seventh graders 44-8 to go into the game against Lubbock for the consolation title. Sudan took an early lead in the Lubbock game and maintained the lead throughout the game. Angela Pickett led the Sudan scoring in both games, scoring 14 in the Muleshoe game and 11 against Lubbock. Marie Tamplin also figured in the scoring by adding 13 points against Muleshoe and 8 against Lubbock.

The junior high teams will remain idle until after the Christmas holidays, but the varsity and B-teams saw action Tuesday night against Amherst, although the results were not available at press time.

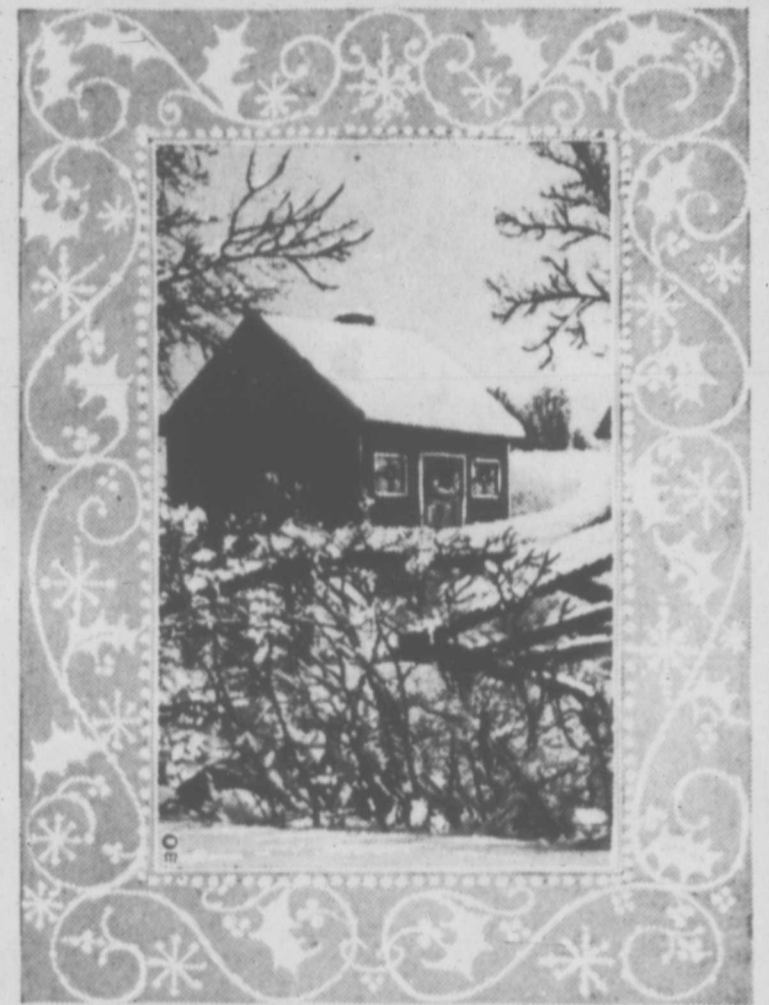



Devotional

TAXES, SILENCE
LIGHT AND SOUND

Scripture: St. Luke 2: 1-20;
"Glory to God in the highest,
and on earth peace, good will
toward men."
Taxes—this seems a familiar
yet strange thing which begins
our Christmas story in the gospel
of Luke. But is it not true that
God sometimes uses the least,
the familiar or ordinary things
of this earth to speak His message
of eternal truth in a way that we
can understand now? Certainly today
we know about paying taxes. And
so we can understand that Joseph
and Mary had no choice but to go
up to Bethlehem "to be taxed."
But God had a plan, which was
that Jesus was to be born (in the

City of David) in Bethlehem.
"And so it was..."
"And she brought forth her first-
born son, and wrapped Him in
swaddling clothes, and laid Him
in a manger; for there was no
room for them in the inn."
Silence—the Shepherds were
alone in the deep silence of the
night, in the fields where they
kept watch over their sheep at
night. All was quiet, and the
senses of man seem to become
keen and alert in silence. Thus,
it is that within the silence of the
soul, man hears the "still, small
voice" of God's Spirit speak to
him. But will you find a quiet
time to be still, and listen, and

open your eyes to see by the
Light of God's Word? His Word
says "Be still, and know that I
am God."

In the silence of the heart we
come to believe in Jesus Christ
as the Son of God sent to save us
from our sins, and with the
mouth, with words, confession
is made unto salvation. If you
will hear, God is calling you to
"come, and I will in no wise cast
you out." The shepherds heard,
and saw, and went to Jesus! Then
they went out to tell about Him
"glorifying and praising God."
Jesus Christ is Lord, but have you
really accepted Him as Son of
God? Do you know Him as your
Personal Savior? If you will accept
Him, ask forgiveness of your sins
and turn to Him in trust, you will
find Him, for He eagerly, plead-
ingly awaits you, seeks you to be
His own child.

Light—"The glory of the Lord
shone round about them, and they
were sore afraid." In the silence
of the dark night, brilliant dan-
gling light was the first thing
of which the shepherds were aware,
and we can certainly understand
their fear. But the angel spoke
to them, and they heard.

"Fear not, for behold I bring
you good tidings of great joy,
which shall be to all people."
"For unto you is born this day
in the city of David, a Savior,
which is Christ the Lord."

This is truth! Jesus Christ is
Lord, A Savior provided to save
you and me from sin and death
into love and life eternal if we
accept Him, this gift of Eternal
Life from God.

Words—God never has left us
alone without His Word. The vision,
the seeing would sometimes
remain a mystery if we had no
word to explain the meaning.
(Try watching your TV with the
sound turned off, and you will
better understand this.) But God
gave us His printed Word, The
Bible, and has preserved it for us
through wars, death, fires, floods
and these many years. If you feel
the desire to come to Jesus Christ,
it is God's Holy Spirit calling
you. If you are a Christian seek-
ing to follow Jesus to know Him
better, to be a better witness of
Him to others, to be comforted,
assured, delighted, joyful, guided
in the way, then turn up the sound
and hear His Word as you read the
Bible and pray. Thus in your
silence will be guided by both
sight and sound in the Light of
His presence.

God has come down in Jesus,
the Babe in the Manger, to save
us from our sin. Will you accept
His gift of Love? Then, do as the
shepherds did after they had heard
of Jesus.

"And it came to pass, as the

them into heaven, the shepherds
