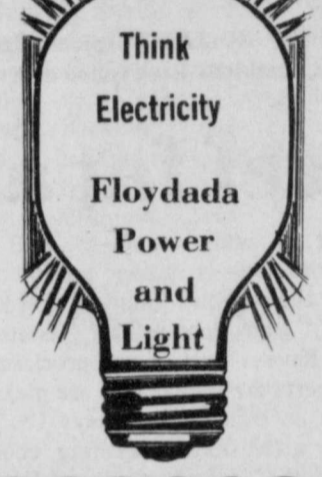
Tax rebates continue decline

Floydada's sales tax rebate for sales made in April came to \$5,543.61, bringing the year to date total to \$48,888.13. This is a 6.78 percent decline from the same period in 1985.

Lubbock - \$6,619,304, up 1.40 percent.
Matador - \$10,710, up 1.50 percent.
Petersburg - \$10,641, down 10 percent.

Lockney's rebate totaled \$2,428.62. This brings their total to \$22,039.25 for the year to date, showing a decline of 4.97 percent from rebates in the same time frame of 1985.

Plainview - \$78,153, up 6.96 percent.
Quitque - \$6,698, up 11.6 percent.
Ralls - \$26,095, down 4.40 percent.
Silverton - \$9,775, down 0.8 percent.


