## DO WE WANT NEW INDUSTRY

There are 18,000 to 20,000 agencies looking for 1,500 industries each year; 750 of these are pre-determined locations, leaving 750 possibilities. This means we stand a chance of locating one out of every one hundred prospects. We must constantly stay on the alert. We cannot afford to relax if we are to compete for industry.

EVERYONE IS A SALESMAN...

An industrial prospect stopped in a midwestern city. The prospect was represented by two men who were flying around that state and adjoining states in a private plane looking for a potential location for their new branch plant. They had been highly encouraged to visit a certain city.

The prospects understood that this community contained the physical factors that they might want. i. e. Industrial land, utilities, and highway access. They had gone to this community with high expectations as to the possibility of locating their branch plant there, and thus ending their search.

They landed at the local airport and took a taxi cab to the business area. Without saying who they were or why they were there, they questioned store people, wattresses and others as to what they thought of the community. They were told of the problems in the school and what thay couldn't buy in the stores and the high cost of living. One even said she would move out of town tomorrow if she could ever make enough morey in this miserable place to get out of it.

The prospects turned aoound ; and left this community which they had entered with such high expectations; in fact, they crossed it completely off their list of possibilities.

A few weeks later in another city neraby, a local taxi driver was being honored with an appropriately inscribed fountain pen set as a reward for a service he had performed on behalf of his community. It seemed that two industrialists in a private plane had landed in this community one evening. They stopped merely because it was getting dark and this was a fair size town with a good motel. They had no intention of looking at it as a location for their plant. Without knowing who they were the taxi driver began to extol the virtues of his community. He told them they had good city government, good schools, and retail stores, and that only fine people lived there. It was a place he said, "where everyone worked together for the community interest," and, in his opinion, "it was the best community in the world in which to raise a family."

Early the next morning, the prospects went to the local industrial development man and asked him to show them the community as a potential location for their new branch plant. Of course, these were the same two men.

About two years later this company located its plant in this city. It is still employing from 75 to 100 people.
