

California Services For Winifred Bell Cloutier

Funeral services for Winifred Bell Cloutier were held November 1, 1968 in Burbank, California, with Dr. Don Bertheau officiating. Burial was in Glen Haven Memorial Park, San Fernando, California. She died Oct. 29, 1968 in St. Joseph's Hospital in Burbank, following a brief illness.

"Winnie" as she was lovingly known to her relatives and friends was born on a farm in the Admiral Community in Callahan County, Texas, July 11, 1906, the daughter of J. R. Finch and wife Cora L. Finch. She spent the greater part of her girlhood days in Callahan County, and moved, as a young woman to Los Angeles, California, where she spent the remainder of her life.

She is survived by three sons, Harvey, Bruce and Roger Bell, and one daughter Cora Margaret, and one brother Walter Scott Finch, all of California; an aunt Mrs. Olin Jones of Baird, two nieces Mrs. Lorene Flores of Baird, and Mrs. Juanita Fincher, of Lake Tahoe, California, several other relatives and many friends.

Those who were able to share some hours with my mother before her surgery know the special and beautiful glow she radiated.
