are currently being mailed to registered voters. The new white certificates will be valid from March 1, 1988 through December 31, 1989. However, you will need Co keep your current yellow
certificate since they are valid certificate since they are
through February 28, 1988, says Hugh Moseley, voter registrar. If you have moved or if you have changed your mailing address from a box to a street address or
vice versa, and have not notified the voter registrar of your change, you will not receive a new certificate. These certificates are
not forwardable and will be returned to the voter registrar.

You will need to contact voter registrar at the Parmer County Tax Office in Farwell and
fill out a change card and receive your new certificate. If you do not receive your new certificate and
you are still a resident of Parmer County and wish to remain a registered voter, you must make this change.
