## Makes aboun 3 dozan

6 tbsp butter softened
1 cup confectioners' sugar
1 egg
2 oz unsweetened chocolate, melted and cooled 2 tsp vanilla extract
$1 / 2$ cups all-purpose flo
$1 / 2$ tsp baking soda
Filling:
$1 / 3$ cup cream cheese, softened
1 tsp vanilla extract
$1 / 2$ cup finely chopped peca

1. In a small bowl, cream the butter and confectioners' sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in egg, chocolate and vanilla. Com-
bine the flour and baking soda; gradually add to the creamed bine the flour and baking soda; gradually add to
mixture and mix well. Refrigerate for one hour. mixture and mix well. Refrigerate for one hour.
2. In another bowl, beat the cream cheese and vanilla until 2. In another bowl, beat the cream cheese and vanilla untit
smooth. Stir in coconut and nuts. Refrigerate for one hour. 3. Shape dough into an $81 / 2$ inch $\times 6$ inch rectangle. Shape dough around filling, sealing the seam. Wrap in plastic wrap and refrigerate for 2-3 hours or until firm.

bolic of Austria and Bavaria for us. The first was pancake soup as an appetizer, which is a clear broth filled with very thin strips of pancakes. The second food pork schnitzel, and the third was apple strudel. Most of us tired apple strudel. Most of us tired
