GENERAL MAAS THREATENS TO
EXECUTE SEVEN AMERICANS WHOM HE HAS ARRESTED

New Orleans, April 25-Wireless advices from General Maas of the Mexican forces, had found seven American prisoners guilty of certain charges and that he proposes to execute them. Consul Canada at Vera Cruz, the wireless says, has notified him and the state department at Washington of the reported intentions of General Mas to ex ecute certain American prisoners. It was further stated that General Maas had about thirty-three prisoners, including fourteen women and seven or eight children. The consul sent a messeger to General Maas appealing to him in the name of humanity to release the women and children.
The nature of the charges against the seven Americans was not indicated by wireless, or whether they were giv en a trial.
