California, July 6, via wireless to San Diego, July 7.—In fighting yesterday outside Guaymas, the constitutionalists were repulsed with considerable loss according to a dispatch received at federal headquarters in Mazatlan. The federal gunboat Guerrero shelled the enemy's position, near Cruz de Pedras. The federal losses were given as several killed and many wounded. Skirmishing continued today.
