ATHENS, July 23 (Greek Official Agency).—Preparing the Greek army for its offensive against the Turkish nationalists was a more difficult task than gaining victories in the recent advance into Asia Minor, declared General Papoulas, Greek commander-in-chief on the Smyrna front, today.

### THOSE MAKING MILLION PAY AROUND TWO-THIRDS TO THE U. S. GOVERNMENT

WASHINGTON, July 25.—Persons who are making a million dollars or more net income are paying the government practically two-thirds of it in taxes, according to preliminary statistics of income for 1919, issued by the internal revenue bureau.

The 1919 returns showed the 47 individuals with net incomes of \$1,000,000 or more had included one with a net income of \$5,000,000 or more; two with net incomes of \$4,000,000 to \$5,000,000; four with net incomes of \$3,000,000 to \$4,000,000; 11 with net incomes of \$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000; 14 with net incomes of \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000 and 23 with net incomes of \$1,000,000 to \$1,500,000.

The pageant will be presented in an arena 600 feet by 150, and will employ a cast of more than 5,000 persons. It will trace Missouri's history, from the time the state was a primeval wilderness down to the present era.
