Decline is Shown in the Total Exports and Imports For Month.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 14.—Cotton consumed during September amounted to 455,344 bales of lint and 99,833 bales of linters, compared with 437,713 of lint and 69,710 of linters in September last year, the census bureau announced today.

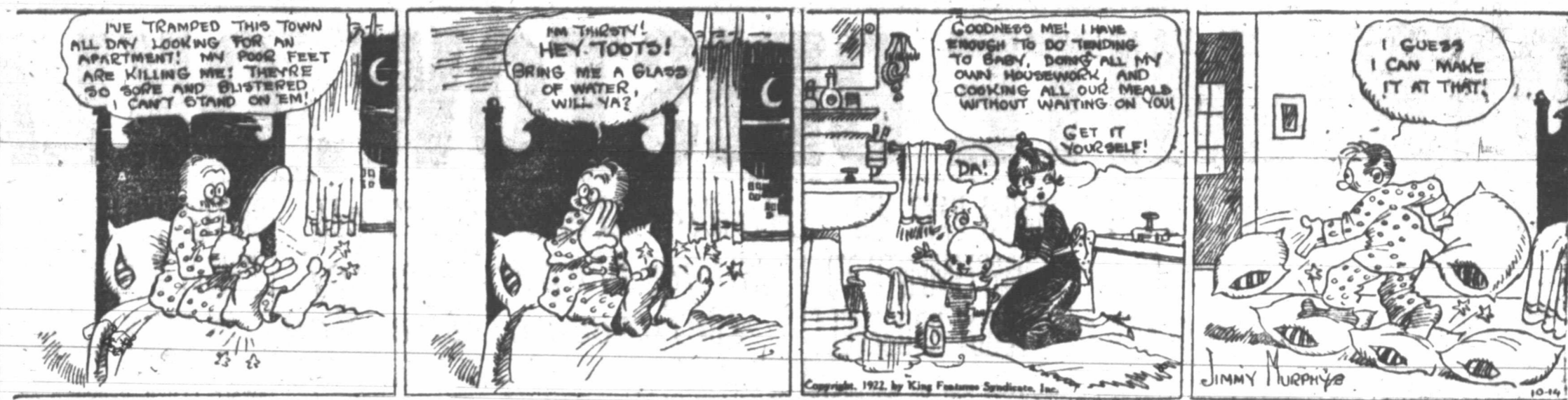

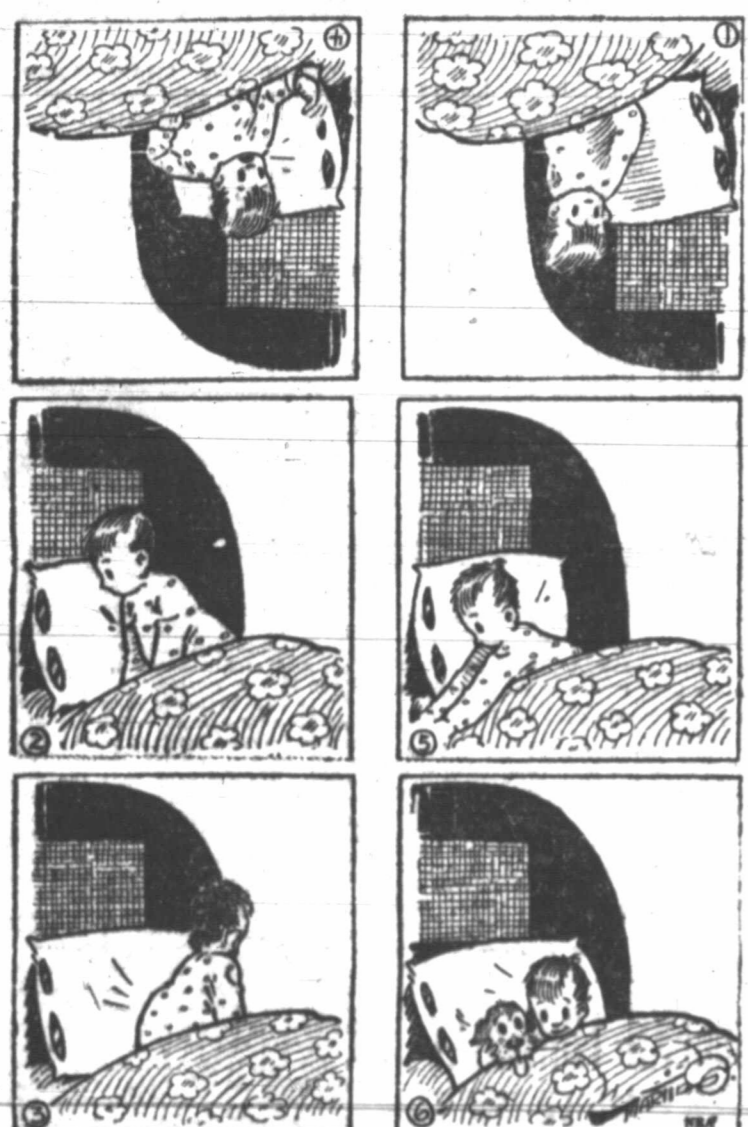

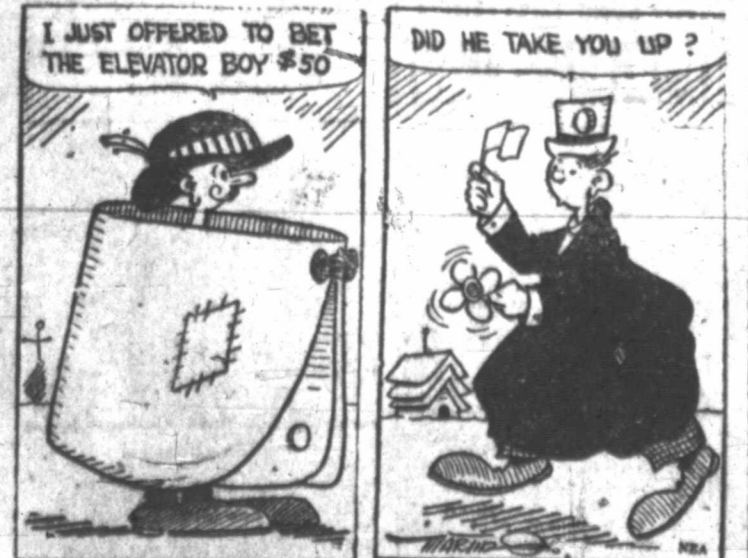
