MAHD board approves 2011 hospital budget

The Muleshoe Area Hospital District's board of directors approve a nine-month, \$8.7 million budget for Muleshoe Area Medical Center during a special meeting Thursday, Dec. 16.

In 2009, the hospital district received permission from Medicare to change its fiscal year to the calendar year — an action that was necessary for the district and hospital to seek reimbursements for patients in the "Pathways" geriatric behavioral unit that had been constructed in a wing of the hospital.

Since that time, the district's contract with Horizon, Inc., to operate the unit has been tossed out the window, and the district is currently in negotiations with

the company to avoid taking the issue into civil court. The MAHD board met in executive session on Wednesday, Dec. 15, to discuss the issue further.

However, rescinding the district's contract with Horizon didn't rewind the tape to 2009, in other words, the district found itself with two separate budgets — one for the hospital and another, which was approved earlier this year, for Park View Nursing Care Center.

At Thursday's meeting, MAHD CEO David Burke explained that the intent of the nine-month budget was to realign the district's two entities so the budget approved for the following year would include both.

As he present the proposed budget for

Area communities receive final 2010 sales tax allotment

The City of Muleshoe took in \$518,624.01 in sales tax during 2010, according to totals announced this month by the Texas State Comptroller's office, including this month's allocation of \$36,634.77.

While the year-to-date total is a 3.11 percent, or \$16,686.77, decrease from last year's numbers from the same period, it places the Bailey County seat in second place in actual sales tax dollars received, compared to

Littlefield's actual total of \$776,359.02

The numbers for the Lamb County seat, which has a higher sales tax rate of 1.75 percent, show a 4.52 percent decrease from its 2009 year-end total.

Only Sudan showed a significant increase in its year-end total. At 15.89 percent, the Muleshoe neighbor received \$6,854.05 more in sales tax.

The race for the year-

to-date totals trophy put Olton at the back of the pack with the largest percentage of decrease, a 7.34 percent drop, or \$8,880.75 from the same period last year.

In the monthly sales tax race, Friona captured first place with a 23.68 percent increase. Muleshoe came in second, with a 3.06 percent, or \$1,088.36.

Olton took last place in the monthly total, as well, with a 21.26 percent drop.

November state sales tax collections and December sales tax allocations to local governments represent sales that occurred in October, according to the state comptroller's office.

Last week, Texas Comptroller Susan Combs said November state sales tax revenue totaled \$1.84 billion, up 8.7 percent compared to November 2009.

approval, Burke talked about the district's strengths and weaknesses, and said, "The biggest strength we have at the hospital are our employees... The people who work here do so because they want to."

The hospital's weakness, Burke said, is its finances, but he said that aspect is getting better and he hopes it will improve even more in the near future.

"This is a conservative budget," Burke said, "expense wise and revenue wise."

Projected expenses in the budget are at \$8,649,977 and projected revenues are at \$8,74,322, which it was noted wouldn't allow for salary increases.

Revenue projections for individual departments at the hospital included the laboratory at \$2.85 million.

"All in all, its making money for the hospital," Burke said about the lab, adding that radiology's projected revenues are \$627, 195, and physical therapy, has projected revenues of \$497,836.

"Sales tax revenue has now grown for eight consecutive months compared to year ago levels, with recent gains above the five percent mark," said Combs. "November's monthly gain showed growth in a range of sectors like manufacturing, the oil and natural gas industry, retail trade and restaurants."

The comptroller will send cities, counties, special purpose districts and transit systems \$435.8 million in December sales tax allocations, up 4.5 percent compared to last December. The final sales tax allocation of 2010 brings local sales tax revenue for the year to \$5.6 billion, a fraction of a percent less than in 2009.

Combs' office will send Texas cities December sales tax allocations of \$290.9 million, up four percent compared to December 2009.

During calendar year 2010, cities received \$3.8 billion in sales tax revenue, up less than one percent compared to the previous year.

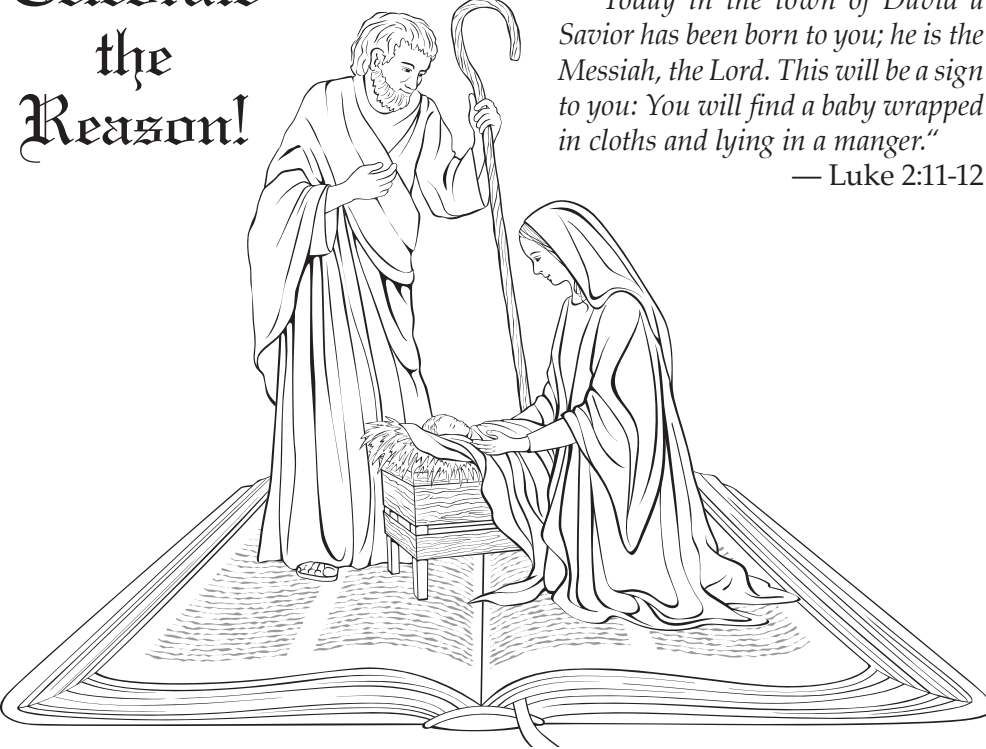

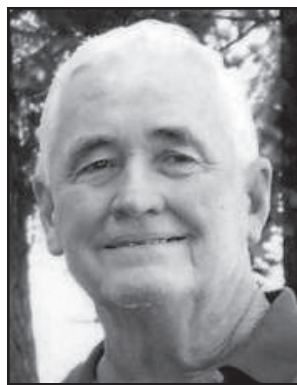

the moment.

And we noted that he delivered unto them his goods. Those goods were talents. He gave one five talents, one two talents and to one he gave one talent. Now we can say the Lord treats everyone alike, but we can never prove it. We can say the Lord wants the same for every one, but we can never prove that either.

We can say the Lord gave to every man according to his several ability. And we will have told the truth.

A talent, so I understand, means a skill, mental or physical ability or gift. And the lord, contrary to what we might at times believe, acted in response to the abilities of his servants, and their actions. Consequently he delivered five talents to one of them, and two to one of them.

But the one that was given one talent virtually destroyed himself. He was afraid of it. I take that to mean miss use of it, or he threw it away. I'm sure most of us have seen people respond in each of these ways. What I mean is what they worked at, or in whatever way seemed best at the time.

But the sad part is, one of them just would not do anything. I've known a number of people, boys and girls, that we could not get involved in anything, job or vocation, so the work they could have done had to be done by some other person and they missed the real beauties

of life.

I could name some of them now if it was proper to do so. But on the other side of the coin I will make brief mention of my father.

He was a good and decent man, and one of numerous talents. He was a school teacher. He sold subscriptions to the Oklahoma Farmer Stockman and the Daily Oklahoma, he owned and operated a grocery store, he farmed and operated a thrashing machine during summer months.

He did office work during early days of the Roosevelt Farm Programs and I learned late in life that he had run for office one time, but he was not elected.

I never heard him mention it, so I don't know what office he had run for. But he consistently manifested an interest in public affairs. And spoke often of U.S. Sen. Thomas P. Gore and of times they had lunch together. My understanding is Sen. Gore was blind, but could do his work remarkably well.

At any rate this is, in my opinion the way a certain man was given talents, and proceeded to trade with them. And I think we see the same thing in principal when we read Paul's letter to Ephesians, chapter four, "I therefore, the vocation wherewith ye are called."

"With all lowliness and meekness, with long suffering forbearing in love; Endeavouring

to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."

"For there is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling" And called

in one vocation.

Thus we see one collective group, called in one hope of their calling — one body, one spirit, and one hope of their calling.
