MAHD Board President Resigns

Chad Nickels, president of the Muleshoe Area Hospital District's board of directors, resigned suddenly during Dec. 13's regular meeting, following an explosive exchange with fellow

board members, hospital district staff and members of the public in attendance.

At the beginning of the meeting, the board members went into closed session to discuss personnel issues, returning an hour and a half later

with the note from the board president that action regarding the executive session would be postponed until later.

After working through the posted agenda, Nickels dropped a bombshell when he made a recommendation that the MAHD CEO, and administrator of the Muleshoe Area Medical Center, David Burke be terminated immediately.

"What... of this hospital? Have you lost your mind?" asked Zonell Baker, who was among the employees in attendance.

Her comment cracked the levy, and eventually a flood of angry words filled the meeting room, resulting in Nickels

More Problems With AccessCare

Problems collecting rent from AccessCare Dialysis resulted in a decision to turn the issue over to its attorney during the Muleshoe Area Hospital District's Dec. 13 board of director's meeting. MAHD CEO David

Burke explained that the company that leases a wing of Parkview Nursing Care Center to provide dialysis services was \$10,000 behind in its rent and efforts to collect the money had been unsuccessful.

"He said the check was in the mail for the

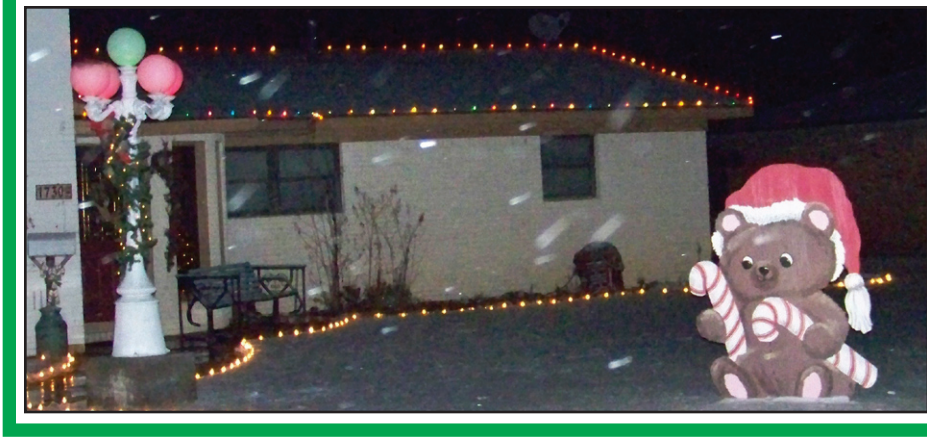


Time To Trim

Sales Tax Allocations Show Increase For Month, Year

The City of Muleshoe took in \$535,702.36 in sales tax during 2011, with the most recent allotment from the Texas State Comptroller's office being \$37,048.32. Compared to last

year's ending total of \$518,624.01, Muleshoe's current collections show an increase of 3.29 percent, year to date, which sets it at the bottom of the list in percentage of increase.

Last year's ending totals showed a 3.11

percent decrease from the amount received in 2009; while the December 2010 allocation showed a 3.06 percent increase from that of December 2009.

When comparing the December 2011 allocation numbers for area communities, the figures received from the Texas State Comptroller's office

show the largest percentage of increase went to Dimmitt with 33.11 percent, representing a dollar increase of \$7,678.88.

At the same time, Muleshoe's allocation for December 2011 shows a 1.12 percent increase, placing it seventh on the area's list.

At the bottom of the month's comparison

is Friona, with an 11.70 percent decrease, representing a drop of \$3303.29.

In actual dollars, the year's collection of \$535,702.36, as can be expected, is second only to Littlefield, which received a total of \$916,112.87 for 2011.

The recent allocation represent sales tax collected by merchants

in October, and reported to the state in November.

On Dec. 7, Texas Comptroller's office announced that state sales tax revenue in November was \$2.07 billion, up 12.2 percent compared to November 2010. State sales tax revenue has now increased for 20

Police Chief Warns Of Bail Bond Scam

Whether or not an elderly individual has been run over by a wayward sleigh-driving relative, it's best not to send money to bail him out of jail until you can verify the event, and your relative's need.

According to Muleshoe Police Chief Brian Frieda, the last holiday scam to hit West

Texas is a fraudulent request for bail.

The police chief explained that his department has received reports of individuals claiming to have been arrested to be a relative, or with a relative, of local residents, and requesting that money be wired to post the bond for the resident's

relative.

Frieda said the individuals making the request had apparently gathered enough information about the Muleshoe residents and the "jailed" relative online to make the request, but lacked sufficiently specific information about the relative to allay the

residents' suspicions.

Area residents receiving such requests are warned not to send money until after such a call can be verified.

Contact the Muleshoe Police Department at 272-4569, or the Bailey County Sheriff's Department at 272-4268, to report such requests.

(The following story was written by Terry Hoggitt of The Cushing (Okla.) Daily Citizen, and first appeared in that newspaper almost 30 years ago. We thought you might enjoy the viewpoint of a reporter of 2,000 years ago on that fateful night when the future of the world was changed.)

Western Union — Boss, I know I'm a rookie reporter and I know you're giving me a chance to move up in the newsroom. But Bethlehem? Nothing ever happens in Bethlehem. I'm new at this, and I know I'm supposed to dig up stories. But there isn't much going on here. And I think you're right. It doesn't take long in this business to become cynical about most things and skeptical about everything.

Since I wired that "The Whole World is Taxed" story, it's been very quiet here. People are still coming from all over the country, looking for a place to stay, and standing in line while they pay their taxes. But there's no other news. It would take a miracle to find anything newsworthy in this place. The biggest thing that's happened in the past couple of days was the fuss over my room. There just isn't any space available in Bethlehem. A young couple needed lodging



and the innkeeper asked me if I would give them my room. I think I answered him the way you would have, Boss. I told him I had paid my rent and I was staying. They could go look elsewhere.

The innkeeper said the woman was great with child. I told him I've heard better excuses than that. I've got enough to worry about, trying to file stories, and I can't be running all over this little town looking for another room. According to the innkeeper, he gave the couple some space in the stable behind this building. I doubt if he really did that, but I'm not going to go poking around among the cows and sheep to see if anyone's spending the night there.

Boss, I've scoured the entire area. Nothing. Oh, there's a bunch of shepherds scattered all over a hillside, but those guys don't have much to say. They're too busy keeping watch over their flocks.

Just this afternoon, I went out west of Bethlehem to check on a rumor of some "kings" who are supposedly

coming to this little town. I found three men heading east, but they wouldn't admit to being "kings." They just said (get this, Boss) they were "following a star."

Cracked me up. I saw some sort of light shining in the east, where they pointed. But I think it was one of those sunspots. These wise guys, who would only say they "came from afar," are probably traders. Each is carrying a fancy box on his camel.

It's getting quite late. It's just past midnight. That would make it Dec. 25 and I still don't have that big story you were hoping I'd find. I suppose you'll want me to come home soon. I realize this is a long telegram, but I'm getting the special night rates. And I can't sleep because of some bright light right outside my room — can you see sunspots at night? And the cattle are lowing. It's enough to keep anyone

awake. As I scribble this message, a bunch of those shepherds are rushing past my window and running into that stable out back. Must have lost a lamb. It's funny. I swear I can hear a baby crying. Probably an animal.

My goodness, now those three guys are riding past on their camels. They're headed into the stable, too! Must be getting crowded in there. Cows. Sheep. Shepherds. Three well-dressed salesmen and their camels and some poor couple trying to get a night's sleep.

That innkeeper must be making a fortune tonight! Say, boss, what if that woman really was pregnant? Would that be a story? You know, someone having a baby in a barn? I can imagine the headlines: Baby born in Bethlehem stable; No crib for a bed; Child placed in a manger.

Well, maybe that's a bit farfetched, Boss. But I'll wander out there and see if I can find out something. Might be good for a line or two in the afternoon editions. I'll wire something later in the day, but don't expect a miracle.

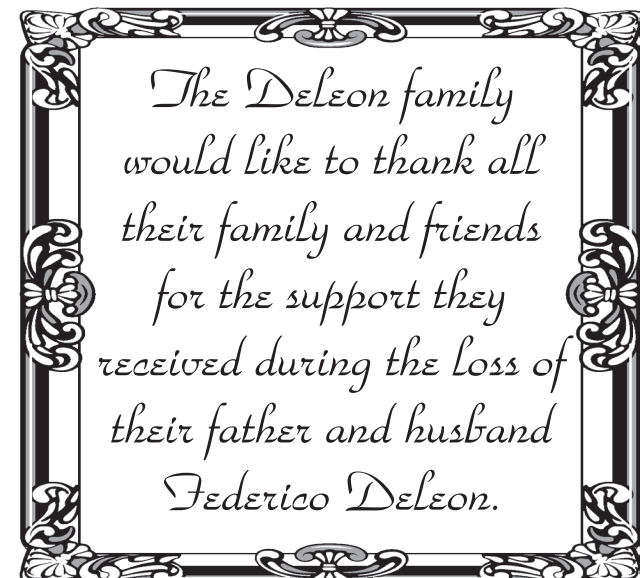

not only resigning as board president — as board member Herb Ramage asked him to do, but also resigning from the board.

"It's time that you step down as president of this board because you won't work with anybody," Ramage said, regarding Nickels' leadership.

"He's totally out of compliance," board vice president Zona Gatewood announced at one point, referring to Nickels, holding up a copy of what she said were the regulations for the governing body of a critical access hospital such as MAMC.

Although Nickels voiced a recommendation to the other board members, his statement wasn't ever presented in the form of a motion, nor was a statement that could have been construed as a second made by another board member.

"This is my recommendation, you can do with it what you want," Nickels said.

While the majority in attendance voiced support of Burke, there

were a few present who apparently liked the idea of getting rid of Burke, referring to the fact that Burke had previously terminated two friends of theirs.

In the explanation Nickels presented for his recommendation, he said it was partly due to the way Burke had terminated a contract with the hospital's pharmaceutical vendor, claiming he would have supported Burke's actions if the vendor had received an opportunity to correct her errors, a comment that brought derisive laughter from some in attendance.

In response, hospital staff at the meeting alleged multiple wrongdoing by the vendor — which they claimed to have documented — that supported the contract's termination.

It was also brought out by Shanna Laughton, the interim administrator at Parkview Nursing Care Center, that Nickels had stated he had a problem with Burke's action because a relative of the vendor was one of Nickels' customers at his

business in Muleshoe.

"That does have some merit," Nickels said, "but it's not the reason I made my decision."

Nickels also alleged that Burke had allowed Parkview to be administered by Laughton without proper state accreditation in hand "for a short period of time," an issue that Nickels said was the reason the closed session took as long as it did.

However, according to Heather Foley, the MAMC administrative assistant who posted the meeting agenda, the only personnel item listed by Gatewood, who asked for it to be placed on the agenda, were problems that existed between members of the hospital board.

"My license is right here," Laughton said during the meeting, holding up the document she had received from the state.

Prior to being hired as the interim administrator at the nursing home, the hospital district reportedly contacted the state and received permission for Laughton — who was already licensed in other states, to serve in that capacity pending the arrival of her Texas license.

Although board member Bill Liles made a motion to adjourn at one point, it died from lack of a second.

"You all should be ashamed... and I am personally disappointed," said one hospital employee,

while employee Bobby Turner accused Nickels of "not listening to the district."

"It's not your job to run this hospital, it's that man's (Burke) and he has proven he can do it," said another employee.

During the open forum, immediately following the return to open session, several of the hospital's employees stood in defense of Burke, apparently choosing to attend the meeting after hearing rumors that the hospital district board may be taking action to dismiss him.

"Outside forces are causing problems," Turner said, adding that when Burke came to the hospital district several of the employees were "just collecting a check," and that the morale at the hospital had changed, due in large part to its current administrator.

"David Burke has assembled a professional staff," Turner said.

Others spoke about some of the current board members, accusing them of "pettiness," and stating the problem within the hospital district was the board, not the employees.

"For the first time we have an administrator who is fair with all of the employees," Suzanne Nickels said, adding that the hospital district's finances were "in the black" because of Burke's financial

leadership.

"David is trying to fix the problems of previous administrators," Lela Ann Smith said. "I sometimes think you only see what's on paper."

"We had a problem with a vendor," Baker said. "She needed to go... people were taking notes about what was being done."

Baker admitted Burke "wasn't perfect," but added, "he's the best we've worked under."

"You were elected to do what is right for the district," Suzanne Nickels said. "Shame on you."

Prior to verbally resigning and walking out of the meeting, Chad Nickels said, "I can see how important he is to you, I won't stand in the way of that."

Nickels said he didn't mean to cause trouble in the district or for its employees. "I really felt like this was the best decision to make," he said. "I'm not the best suited for this job, and I apologize to all of you."

Following Nickels resignation, Gatewood took over as acting president, and adjourned the meeting.

Continued from A1 last four months," said Shanna Laughton, interim administrator of the nursing home, referring to her telephone conversations with John Hedrick, president of the company that operates similar facilities in several other Texas and Oklahoma communities.

"It's very obvious that this man doesn't stick to his word," Burke said.

About a year ago, the hospital district forgave a similar amount because of an error in the district's previous contract with AccessCare; however, a new agreement was reached.

"He wrote the contract," board member Bill Liles pointed out during last week's meeting, prior to making the motion to turn the issue over to the hospital district's attorney.

In other business, the hospital board:

- Discussed the district's overage debt, during which Burke noted that an effort was being made to contact and pay patients from several years ago who were owed various amounts due to overpayments by the patients and the patients' insurance company or Medicare.

"We didn't cause this problem," Liles said, referring to the fact that a large portion of the overages dated back as far as 2002 when former administrators and hospital district officials had apparently stopped sending out the overage payments.

- Discussed the dollar limits required for board approval.

- Discussed the district's collection policies.

"Sales tax revenue in all major economic sectors improved over a year ago," State Comptroller Susan Combs said.

"While sales tax receipts associated with oil and natural gas production remains the strongest source of growth, there were strong increases from the consumer-driven sectors of retail trade and restaurants," she added.

The comptroller's office will send December sales tax allocations totaling \$478.3 million to cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts, up 9.7 percent compared to December 2010.

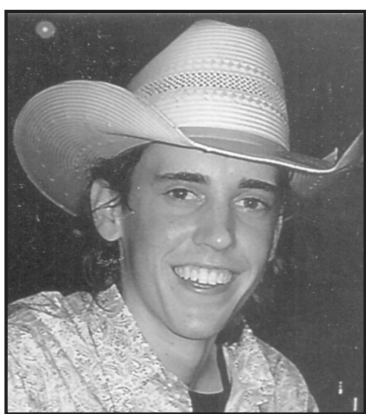
Gary grew up in a musical family, learning to play at an early age. His sons, Cory and Justin both had this same privilege, as they too grew up around music and began playing very

Millions Of Trees Killed By Drought

As many as 500 million trees scattered across the Lone Star State have died this year as a result of the unrelenting drought, according to preliminary estimates from Texas Forest Service.

The numbers were derived by Texas Forest Service foresters, who canvassed local forestry professionals, gathering information from them on the drought and its effect on trees in their respective communities.

Each forestry expert estimated the percentage of trees in their region that have died as a result of the 2011 drought. That percentage was applied to the estimated number of trees in the region, a figure determined by the agency's Forest Inventory & Analysis (FIA) program.

Using this approach, an estimated 100 million to 500 million trees with a diameter of 5 inches or larger were estimated

to have succumbed to the drought. That range is equivalent to 2 to 10 percent of the state's 4.9 billion trees.

"In 2011, Texas experienced an exceptional drought, prolonged high winds and record-setting temperatures. Together, those conditions took a severe toll on trees across the state," said Burl Carraway, Sustainable Forestry department head. "Large numbers of trees in both urban communities and rural forests have died or are struggling to survive. The impacts are numerous and widespread."

The preliminary estimates indicate three multi-county areas appear to be the hardest hit. The area including Sutton, Crockett, western Kimble and eastern Pecos counties saw extensive mortality among Ashe junipers.

The area including Harris, Montgomery, Grimes, Madison and

Leon counties saw extensive mortality among loblolly pines. Western Bastrop and eastern Caldwell counties, as well as surrounding areas, saw extensive mortality among cedars and post oaks.

Additionally, localized pockets of heavy mortality were reported for many other areas.

Texas Forest Service foresters plan to use aerial imagery to conduct a more in-depth analysis in the spring, which is when trees that may have gone into early dormancy — an act of self-preservation — could begin to make a comeback.

A more scientific, long-term study will be completed as the agency collects data through its FIA program. Considered a census for trees, the federally-funded program allows the agency to keep a close watch on trees — and how they're

growing and changing — across the state.

As part of the program, foresters are tasked with surveying certain, designated plots of land each year. Because the state is so big, it takes a decade to complete a full inventory cycle.

"Quantifying the impacts of a statewide drought on tree survival is no small task," Carraway said, noting that Texas was home to 63 million acres of forestland, much of which is in remote areas.

"During this time of year, it's difficult to tell in some cases if a tree is truly dead. And keep in mind that the drought is ongoing. We fully expect mortality percentages to increase if the drought continues."

Texas Milk Production Is Up

Texas milk production totaled 787 million pounds during November, up eight percent from last year's production of 726 million pounds.

October 2011

production totaled 813 million pounds.

The number of milk cows during November averaged 435,000 head, up 20,000 head from last year, but unchanged from the October 2011

number.

Production per cow averaged 1,810 pounds during November, 60 pounds more than last year, but 60 pounds less than October 2011.

Milk production in the 23 states participating in the monthly survey totaled 14.7 billion pounds, up 2.2 percent from production in these same states in November 2010.

October production, at 15.2 billion pounds, was up 2.5 percent from October 2010.

Production per cow during November averaged 1,738 pounds, 16 pounds above a year ago.

The average number of milk cows in the 23 states was 8.48 million head, 108,000 head more than last year but unchanged from October 2011.

Cattle On Feed Up From Last Year

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in Texas feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 3.01 million head on Dec. 1, up six percent from a year ago.

According to the monthly report released by the Texas Field Office, the estimate was down slightly from the Nov. 1 level.

Producers placed 475,000 head in commercial feedlots during November, unchanged from a year ago but down 17 percent from last month.

Texas commercial feeders marketed 450,000 head during November, up two percent from last year, but down three percent from last month.

On Dec. 1, there were 2.55 million head of cattle and calves on feed in the Northern High Plains, 85 percent of the state's total.

The number on feed across the area was up six percent from last year, but down slightly from the November total.

November placements in the Northern High Plains totaled 413,000 head, down 15 percent from the October total.

Marketings were down three percent from last month to 391,000 head.

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States in feedlots with a capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 12.1 million head on Dec. 1. This inventory was four percent above Dec. 1 of last year.

Placements in feedlots during November totaled 2.04 million head, four percent above November 2010.

November placements of cattle and calves weighing less than 600 pounds totaled 755,000 head; 600-699 pounds totaled 499,000 head; 700-799 pounds totaled 375,000 head; 800 pounds and greater totaled 410,000 head.

Marketings of fed cattle during November totaled 1.77 million head, slightly below 2010.

The Mules will travel to Dimmitt to battle the Bobcats Jan. 3 in their second district game.

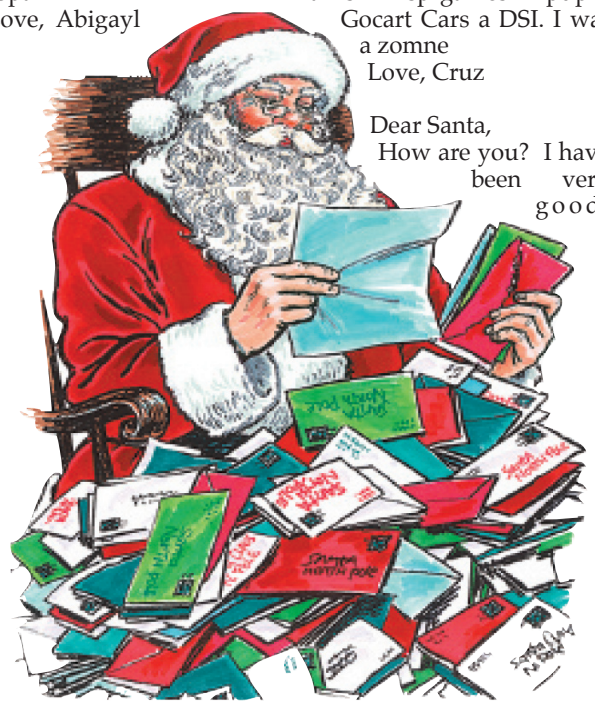
