An Appalling Crime—Shocking Murder of a Young Girl.

[From the Baltimore Gazette.]

The police authorities of Baltimore City yesterday received the details of a horrible murder committed in Jefferson, Texas, on January 21, from J. M. Thomas, chief of Police in that place. A beautiful young lady, apparently not more than twenty years of age, arrived at a hotel there a few days before, accompanied by a man aged about twenty-eight years. They registered as "A. Munroe and lady, Cincinnati, O." The man left on the 21st of January, giving Little Rock, Ark., as his destination. The young woman, who was of light auburn hair, and attired richly in black silk, was discovered after her companion left, murdered in her room. The murderer had battered her face in such a manner as almost to prevent recognition. An accompanying letter of the chief of police was a photograph of the unfortunate woman, which represents a ghastly appearance. Her eyes were gouged out, her face bruised and discolored, and her mouth mashed so as to display her teeth. The photograph was taken of the murdered woman as she lay at full length upon her bed, partly dressed, in the position she was in when discovered. It is one of the most striking illustrations of a terrible crime ever received by the police authorities of this city, and so appalling in the appearance of the victim that it will be apt to remain photographed upon the mind of every one who looks upon it. The murderer has escaped to parts unknown.

That murder will out, this verifies, the man referred to bring the same as above: CINCINNATI, Feb. 18.—A young man named Abe Rothschild attempted to commit suicide this morning by shooting. It has transpired that he murdered a mistress, named Bessie Moore, in Jefferson, Texas, some time ago, where they had been stopping at a hotel. Rothschild was a commercial traveler for a house in this city. His wound is not fatal, and he will be taken to Texas for trial.

Buying a Wife.

LIBERTY, Ind., Feb. 14.—A singular case of a purchase of a wife occurred here recently. An old man named W. M. Smith, aged 70, who lived near here, became a widower some two years ago, and had since lived in entire seclusion. Deaf, demented, and hideous in appearance, though reported wealthy he was abandoned by nearly every one, until finally a few weeks ago he announced his desire again, and offered \$5,000 to any one who would furnish him a wife. The announcement created some little merriment at the time, but nothing farther was thought of it till this morning, when it was announced that the old man was married to Miss Phoebe Johns, a highly respected young lady, aged 17, living in the neighborhood. Inquiry to-day develops the fact that the old man's offer, made several weeks ago, was at once taken up, and by Powell Slade, with whose family the young lady lived, and who commenced negotiations by which the purchase was made. Slade receiving the \$500, \$2,000 of which was given to the girl's father, the girl herself receiving as an inducement a deed from the old man for his farm of 200 acres, very valuable land. The negotiations, which had been pending some time, were completed last week, and the wedding occurred last night in the presence of a number of guests, a grand supper being one of the conditions imposed by the bride before consenting to the sale.

Product of A Jersey Herd.

[From the Turi, Field and Farm.] G. A. Pike, of Winthrop, Me., is the fortunate owner of a herd of eight Maine-bred Jersey Herd Book cows, which are highly prized for the quantity and quality of their lacteal supply. Besides the milk and cream used in the family, averaging about five persons, the dairy produced last year 2,337 pounds of butter, which included 1,374 pounds of a farrow cow. After deducting this amount, the average yield of butter per cow was 275 lbs. Samples of this butter took the first premium at the State Fair. There were also raised from these cows five heifer calves, which took more or less new milk from the dairy. Mr. Pike also slaughtered 1,373 lbs. of pork, besides raising a lot of pigs, all of which were largely produced from the skin of the milk. The food of the cows was such as is ordinary fed to farmers' cows, with the addition, for about nine months of the year, of from two to six quarts of shorts per day, as they seemed to require a greater or less supply.

A SAD SPECTACLE.

—About 7:30 o'clock last evening a sensation was created by the appearance of two handsome and well-dressed young women who were staggering along the avenue, near Seventh street, in a state of maudlin intoxication. For the time they were the observed of all observers. A crowd gathered around them to such an extent, as to block up the sidewalk, seemingly highly amused at the pitiful sight. Sergeant Leach and Detective McDermott arrested and escorted them, followed by a miscellaneous

rabble, to police headquarters, where, upon being questioned, they said their names were Hattie Cole and Maggie Johnson, and they had come over from Baltimore for the purpose of witnessing the counting of the electoral vote and having a good time. One of the girls was brazen and defiant, the other, the younger of the two, wept and pleaded to be allowed to return to her home. Both belong to a theatrical company in Baltimore, and after being detained until they had become sober they were placed on the train and sent back to Baltimore. —Washington Union, 15th.
