Cattle fever ticks have been ound in several South Texas ounties and on one ranch in HOSPITAL NOTES Kent County near Jayton. Oficials of the Texas Animal Health Commission have labled the outbreak the most rious in the last 30 years.

The first ticks reported were ound in Jim Wells County ear Alice and have since pread to Duval McMullen, ive Oak, Nueces and Brooks counties. No explanation has een made of the location on ne premise near Jayton.

Animal Health Commission officials feel that the eradication measures applied in South Texas have the outbreak unoperation of livestock producers. Producers are asked to check their animals closely for fever ticks. If ticks are found, a sample should be placed in a screwworm vial and sent to Austin for identification. The mailing ad-dress is: State-Federal Brucellosis Testing Laboratory, 702 Colorado St., Room 301, Austin Texas, 78701.

The cooperation of all producers is vital so that all infestations of the cattle fever tick can be traced back to the original infestation where eradication measures can be initated. The screwworm is causing livestock producers enough trouble aready—a wide spread fever tick outbreak isn't necessary.,



WHO MUST FILE SOCIAL SECURITY EARNINGS REPORT

Most social security beneficiaries who earned over \$1680 in 1970 are required to file a report of their earnings with the Social Security Administration by April 15, 1971. This report is in addition to any Federal or State tax return, and it must be filed with the Social Security Administration, according to J. M. Talbot, social security manager.

Beneficiaries who were 72 years old in all months of last year are not required to file the annual report of earnings. Disabled beneficiaries should report immediately if they become self-employed or take a job. All other beneficiaries, including families of disabled persons, are under the retirement test and must report their earnings annually.

The purpose of social security benefits is to replace earnings lost due to retirement, death, or disability. If an individual continues to earn a substantial amount - \$1680 or more - some adjustment is made in the amount of his benefits. One dollar for every two dollars earned between \$1680 and \$2880 is withheld. If a individual earns over \$2880, he gives up a dollar for each dollar earned over \$2880 regardless of the amount of yearly earnings. A beneficiary is entitled to his full social security check for any month in which he does not earn over \$140 and is not self-employed. The annual report will allow us to determine whether or not additional benefits are pay-




