THREATENED MONEY CRASH IN ENGLAND.
New developments of fraud continue to come to light in connection with the City of Glasgow bank failure, and the flurry of anxiety at first felt has increased to a deep and wide-spread dread of a financial panic, which threatens to involve the business and commerce of Great Britain. The losses of the bank amount to over \$30,000,000, its capital having been \$20,000,000. A systematic course of fraud and perjury had been followed for years in building up the weekly statement of the bank's condition, and the result was a steady accumulation of debt and a corresponding increase in the amount of the bank's liabilities. The bank's assets were found to be entirely inadequate to meet its obligations, and the result was a general panic in the financial world.
