

STATE CAPITAL NOTES.

Austin, April 11.—In the house the whole day was spent in discussing the proposition to strike out the appropriation of \$150,000 for the protection of the frontier.

Finley's argument favoring frontier protection was pronounced the finest of the session. The motion to strike out was lost by a vote of 42 to 32.

Under this moved to strike out \$150,000 and insert \$100,000. Pending which the house adjourned.

The bill allowing China to compromise their indebtedness, etc., passed.
