STATE CAPITAL NOTES.

Austin, April 17.—The senate agrees to the reduction of the appropriation for frontier protection to \$100,000, but disagrees to many amendments of the house. A conference committee was appointed.

A bill passed eliminating the general revenue of poll tax from the school appropriation.

The house has refused to concur in some of the senate amendments to the war bill. A conference committee has been appointed.

A BLOODY DOUBLE MURDER AT EAGLE PASS.

Eagle Pass, April 17.—A Mexican named Isaacman Mopus was arrested Sunday for murdering and threatening to kill his young wife, being released Tuesday. Last night he proceeded to murder the woman. The latter, horribly gashed in the throat and neck, broke from him and ran, falling dead near the court-house. Attracted by the cries of the woman, a Mexican came to the rescue, but Mopus set upon and fearfully cut him with his ax. He fled this morning.

The wounded woman's adopted daughter was saved by the deed. Immediately officers and citizens went in search of the murderer, but he escaped. Col. Thompson, commander at Pecos, has promised our sheriff to use all means to capture the murderer if on the Mexican side.
