Farmers, as a rule, seem to think that gardening is of so little importance, that they have no time to pay any attention to it. Some so far ignore it that they will not even fence off a piece of ground for the purpose, and if they do, seem to begrudge the manuse needed to keep it in the best condition. I have traveled in the west for miles without seeing an enclosed garden, where farms comprised one and two hundred across each.

How these people live, or rather what they live upon, has often been a subject of wonder to me.

A good garden well managed, is to our notion, just as indispensable to proper living as any one thing that could be named.
