Washington, June 23.—The following is a summary of the president's message returning the judicial expense bill to the house without his signature:
The president begins by reciting a passage of the original legislative bill, repealing title 26 of the revised statutes, and its return to the house without his signature. The object of the present hill, he says, is not to rapeal the election laws, but to defeat their enactment under existing laws. The failure of congress to make appropriations required for the execution of the provisions of the elections laws, would not prevent their enfor the execution of the provisions of the elections laws, would not prevent their enforcement. 
