A RECUPERATIVE COUNTRY.

The power of recuperation from bad seasons in southwestern Texas is one of the most remarkable features of the country, and will fully out-weigh every other drawback charged against it. In nearly every other section of the country the agricultural seasons are so short that there is a month or two of drought, let the frost come in the fall, let the spring be a little earlier in the fall, let any unusual occurrence interfere with the crop, at any time, and the consequences are serious if not ruinous to the farmer's prospects for that particular year at least. But here it is different. From the earliest planting to the latest harvest time the season is so long that the energetic, industrious farmer can scarcely fail of getting at least one good crop, no matter how unpropitious the season may be. We have several months of planting season with a prospect for successfully maturing many crops, against seven weeks in the middle or northern states. Take the present year for an example. It has been the driest known in thirty years. But in all these sections where the rain fell in June the crops, though short, cannot be classed as failures. That rain saved a good portion of the crop already planted, while others ripened and were ready for harvest. The water which was so scarce for food can be raised from the ground here in nearly every month in the year, and those who believe the farmers of western Texas, with all the drought, have not produced enough this year to maintain themselves at least are greatly mistaken.

THE SILVER DOLLAR.

A Washington special to the St. Louis Republican says a very decided effort is being made by the treasury department to have the standard silver dollar established. The demand for it has grown steadily. Sherman issued his order in disbursing officers to pay it out, but next day the treasurer, Gillilan, proceeded to pay in silver ten per cent. of the amounts due the department clerks. Mr. Gillilan thinks that if he could pay out ten per cent. of the joint expense he would very soon get into circulation the mass of silver in the treasury that has been growing larger and larger after each month's coinage. Last fall by means of circulars addressed to national banks offering special inducements to them he succeeded in getting rid of the silver about as fast as it was coined, but Secretary Sherman directed him to stop these efforts, as in his opinion they were contrary to the spirit of the resumption act. For the quarter beginning July 1, 1878, and ending October 1, the amount of silver dollars in circulation increased from \$85,143 to \$4,001,927. After the effect ceased in obedience to the order of the secretary the amount in circulation at the end of each quarter was as follows: January 1, 1879, \$5,229,272; April 1, 1879, \$6,221,899; June 1, 1879, \$6,495,655. This was an increase of something like \$250,000 a month. More than thirty millions of silver dollars are now piled up in the treasury.
