Regulating the purchase and sale of Country Produce.

Es It Omative by the City Council of the City of San Antonio:

Sec. I. Thai no person not duly licensed in accordance with law shall be permitted to purchase in this city, any country produce, eggs or ponitry, for the purpose of re-selling the same.

Any licensed dealer may purchase for that purpose, provided the same shall, not be re-sold except at their regular place of business.

Any person violating the provisious of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than five nor more than twonty dollars, or in default of payment be committed to the city fall for not less than five days, nor more than twenty day.
