Nothing will satisfy that paper but the paper free school system. Wonder how that paper can give Roberts such a hearty support, or belonging to the star chamber, does it know how much truth there is in the statement that the governor is now an ardent supporter of the free school even generally prevailing.

The Gilchrist Journal wants an immigration home established in that city. Palestine is building one, and San Antonio has one already completed. We hope there will be plenty of us for these homes. There ought to be more than a hundred thousand immigrants coming year. There is plenty of room for them and they will be heartily welcomed and well treated by our people. Population means wealth. Western Texas can support a million industrious people to beauty.

The following agricultural note is from the Pecos Valley Chronicle: To show the great fertility and duplicity of the lands of Wilson county, we have been shown samples of corn from the farm of Mr. T. J. Pacon, of the Ohio, taken from land that has not been plowed since two harvests, which would stand the test and would be called good corn in any country. The land has been in cultivation since 1853, but one year rest during that time, and of course has never had any fertilizing agent put on it, as that is an unknown thing on the farms of this country.

The Houston Post thinks the minority in the state convention held their opportunity to kill when they submitted to the nomination of officers before the adoption of a platform, but we only believe the Post history on that point by stating that the loss mentioned in getting at the minority was not looking for better opportunities. About the greatest thing the minority were looking for and failed to find was respectful hearing and treatment at the hands of the majority. There were plenty of opportunities to both presented. It was the lack of disposition and not opportunity that prevented it.

THE INDIAN TROUBLES.

Reports from the Indian war on the frontier are at variance. Gen. Grierson, who reports of a very satisfactory nature concerning his treatment of the hostiles, has been followed by a general order to drive the enemy from pillar to post, but private advices are of a very different nature, and in many instances are the reverse of complimentary to the commanding officer of the "army in the field." So overwhelming is the testimony of the respectable citizens and circumstances, that just for Government with the many reports received, can doubt that Grierson's first reported victory was a humiliating defeat, and with this fact in mind the convincing force of later reports from that officer is lost.

Latest private reports indicate that the Indians are ravaging the country between Davis and El Paso, and Grierson's command is unable to cope with them, though Gen. It is openly charged that Grierson was very slow to strike when he was within reaching distance of the Indians, that the Indians captured a stage and with this fact in mind the convincing force of later reports from that officer is lost. Latest private reports indicate that the Indians are ravaging the country between Davis and El Paso, and Grierson's command is unable to cope with them, though Gen. Grierson's last report indicates that he has driven them to refuge. It is openly charged that Grierson was very slow to strike when he was within reaching distance of the Indians, that the Indians captured a stage and with this fact in mind the convincing force of later reports from that officer is lost.

The Indians, equipped with ammunition, have been raiding in Western Texas, killing people and destroying and carrying away property, and our troops have failed to capture them. It is understood, however, that the war department is inclined to grant a court-martial. Whittaker's friends are said to have urged Mr. Ramsey to grant a court-martial, and have filed papers with that request, both at the war department and at the White House. They protest that Whittaker's punishment should be approved of the findings of the board of inquiry without giving Whittaker a chance would bring an innocent man guilty for life. On the other hand it is asserted that a court-martial would please the republican leaders who would attempt to make party capital out of the trial.

On the fractional currency issued by the government during and after the war, \$15,000,000 is reported as still outstanding.
