When the democracy first came into power, the American Union was composed of but thirteen states, whereas now there were thirty-eight. This addition, twenty-five in number, had been made under democratic administrations, and excepting frozen and iec-bound Alaska, no territory had been added to the Union save by the democracy. The party to which the senator said he belonged had done this, and, saked he, "Do you blame ms for being proud because I am a democrat?"

The democracy ind fought the knownothing party—a party which proscribed against Catholice and foreign-born citizens and contended against liens. The democracy battled for freedom, equal rights and impartial justice, and Henry A. Wise, of Virginia, the noble leader of the party in the Old Dominion state, put a stop to knownothingism.

While upon this subject, the speaker referred to Rhode Island, as a republican state m which the principles of know-nothingism were still embodied in the state constitution. A foreign-born citizen was not allowed to vote in this state unless he owned a certain amount of real estate, and the democratic senate recently sent a committee to that state to examine into the matter and report upon it; because it was regarded as upconstitutional. The committee investigated and found that even foreign-born men who had fought in the Union army and lost arms and legs had been diequalized from voting, that the lands of others had been seized and sold and the parties disfranchised. While this was the case in republican Rhode Island, in democratic Virginia the Union soldier, no matter how poor, was any man's equal.

the standard of the constitution and fought under it, knowing neither north nor south, and was true to the flag of the country.

Senator Coke then dwelt upon the many legislative errors of the ropublican party, and particularly censured it for having created a bonded debt bearing interest for the beneft of a few men. He opposed the respublican financial policy as detrimental to the interests of the great mass of the people. He then referred to republican outrages in Texas, and how men had been forced to march to the polis between armed soldiers,—how men had been mardered for resisting arrest when no warrants had been issued—

those gentemen who were the uniform of this government were lovers of the liberties of the people.

Said Senator Coke, "I am very earnest and equally houest in all I say to you, fellow-citizens, and my destiny and fate have been bound up with the bonor, advancement and glory of this proud state and her people; and if I fait to give you a proper exposition of my principles as one of her leaders, attribute it to my earnestness. Democracy, I say to you, means your right to elect your home authorities, the federal authorities at Washington, notwithstanding. Republicanifm means the establishment of an aristocracy that will fernish fithe platform on which monarchy and imperialism will be put forth."

The speaker then quoted from a speech made by Mr. Garfield in the XXXVIII congress, second session, found on the 446th page of the Congressional Globe, viz: "I believe, Mr. Speaker, that the fame of Jefferson is waning, and the fame of Hamilton is waxing in the estimation of the American people, and that we are gravitating towards a stronger government. I am glad we are." It was evident from this that Mr. Garfield was opposed to a government of the people, for the secole and by the people.


