He was fishing on Back river when they came along in a boat and sbook to crotten, and they stayed together here for five days. During this time the Iruits killed a number of seels and gave them to the white men. They gave her hashad a chopping knife. The kuife is now lost. At the end of five days they all started for Adelaide peninsula, fearing that the ice, which was rotten, might not let them across. The white men followed, dragging their heavy sledge and boat, and could not cross the rotten lee of them at Gladman's point. The Iruits could not cross the mainland.
