KU-KLUX-KLAN.
Interesting Correspondence Between
Hon. Wade Hampton and Secretary
Sherman.

Washington, October 18.—Secretary Sherman
to-day furnished for publication the
following correspondence, consisting of four
letters, which have passed between himself
and Senator Hampton, of South Carolina:
DAZZON FRANCES, S. C., Sept. 17, 1880.
Hon. John Sherman, Secretary of the Treasury:
Six or seven days ago I saw in your issue
your speech at a conference held by the
national republican committee at the
Fifth Avenue hotel, New York, and you
expressed your views on the following
language: "And now you are asked to
surrender all you have done into the hands
of Wade Hampton and the Ku-Klux-Klan,
and the little segment in the north that is
called the democratic party." May I ask if you
used these words, and if you did, did you
mean to connect me directly or indirectly
with what is known as the Ku-Klux-Klan?
Requesting an early reply addressed to me,
care of August Belmont, New York.

Sir—Your note of the 17th inst. is
received, in which you inquire whether I
used the words, and if you did, did you
mean to connect me directly or indirectly

SERIOUS POLITICAL RIOT.
Democratic Procession Fired on by a
Negro Mob—Fire Returned and a
Lively Battle Ensues—Several
Battly Wounded.

Philadelphia, October 18.—A special to
the Times gives the following particulars of
political disturbances at Wilmington, Del.,
Saturday night. On the route of the democ-
ratic parade last night, at the southwest
corner of 9th and Walnut streets, is a three-
story brick building, known as National hall,
the lower story of which is occupied by two
colored families, a barber shop and a cigar
store, kept by colored people. In the
second story is Higgins' colored
club headquarters. Here a festival of some
kind, gotten up by two colored women, was
in progress. Two clubs had passed down
West street, and the third club, "Bliss
Horse and Cattle," was passing this hall
when a stone was thrown from the side-
walk into a transparency which the club
carried. The club passed about fifty yards
before it was generally known that this had
been done. When it became known to the
club, it halted and the marshal said, "We
have been insulted, all who are to follow me
come out; all who are not get out of the
way." Then the negro broke for the
corralo club, next in line, numbering eighty-
five men, had reached the hall when another
stone was thrown, which struck its lieutenant
colonel, Thomas A. Kane, with such force
as to stagger him in his seat, he being
mounted. Almost simultaneously two
patrol shots were fired, which, being
totally unprepared, there being only six re-
serves among the marchers, broke and
scattered in the midst of a dense volley of
shots from the building, by which several of
the members of this club were wounded.
From the fact that some of the marchers
shot wounds, added to direct testimony, it
appears that some of the negroes were armed
with muskets. The "Bliss Horse and Cattle"
and the Williams clubs came rushing up
and returned the fire, and for two or three
minutes there was hot firing on both
sides. Then the negro broke for the
corralo club, next in line, numbering eighty-
five men, had reached the hall when another
stone was thrown, which struck its lieutenant
colonel, Thomas A. Kane, with such force
as to stagger him in his seat, he being
mounted. Almost simultaneously two
patrol shots were fired, which, being
totally unprepared, there being only six re-
serves among the marchers, broke and
scattered in the midst of a dense volley of
shots from the building, by which several of
the members of this club were wounded.
