Davis, November 4. - At the opening of court today Lieut. Flipper said he had considered the judge Shafter's suggestion of yesterday to try the original and additional charges together, and would accept it voluntarily, waiving any right of challenge he might have to the court as now organized, and consent to re-arranging it and going to trial on both sets of charges, but that he would not ask it. The judge, however, declined to proceed that way unless the accused would ask that the charges be separated into two separate trials. The additional charges are of similar character. Flipper was then arraigned charged with "subduing three thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine dollars and seventy-seven cents between July and August 1880, and with making false statements in writing to his commanding officer on the 20th and 21st of July, to effect that he had transmitted the above amount to the chief commissary, and with presenting a fraudulent check for \$140.41 to his commanding officer when submitting his funds to the chief commissary, with making additional false statements on August 10th in reference to transmitting funds to the chief commissary, which charges he pleaded "not guilty."
