### Our Imports for the Last Fiscal Year

Bradtrest's Nov. 2

The treasury department has published a comparative statement of articles imported and exports for the fiscal year 1909-10, which on the whole shows the appearance of a large increase in imports, an increase so large as to throw the question of the effect of the tariff changes into doubt. It would have been better had the statement been accompanied by some explanation showing the exceptional character of many of the articles imported.

The total value of imports was \$1,243,801,000, of which a total of \$113,011,000, or 9.1 per cent, was from the British empire, \$1,050,000,000, or 84.6 per cent, was from other countries. The increase in imports over the previous year was \$181,000,000, or 14.6 per cent.

Among the articles showing the largest increase in value were sugar, \$181,000,000, or 14.6 per cent; cotton, \$150,000,000, or 12.1 per cent; iron and steel, \$100,000,000, or 8.1 per cent; and other articles, \$100,000,000, or 8.1 per cent.

The total value of exports was \$1,110,000,000, of which a total of \$110,000,000, or 9.9 per cent, was to the British empire, \$1,000,000,000, or 90.1 per cent, was to other countries. The decrease in exports over the previous year was \$100,000,000, or 8.1 per cent.
