SECRETARY SHERMAN has developed an unexpected weakness in connection with the purchase of the government steamer of 1880, which was possible on the 21st of next month. He has fixed a price, \$102,400, which he will pay for them, and as the government will only have to pay 100 when it calls them in for payment at maturity, Mr. Sherman very properly refuses to pay more than the price named, although no holders seem to have been willing to sell at that figure.

The proportion of native to foreign population in New York has largely increased during the last ten years. In 1870 the foreign-born population numbered 419,084, the native-born being 223,198. The late census shows that there were, in June last, 737,000 native and 478,000 foreign-born residents of the city. While the foreign-born population has increased only 29,000 the native-born shows an increase of 203,900. The native now outnumber the foreign-born by 249,000. In 1870 the excess was only 43,000.

A PROPOSAL was submitted to the city council of Galveston Monday night, by its finance committee, to ask the legislature for a charter amendment by which the city may issue a million and a half of bonds, having fifty years to run, to be used for the purpose of refunding the city debt. The bonds are to be sold at least ten percent above the dollar, and the proceeds to be used in retiring outstanding liabilities. The proposition went over until the next meeting. Galveston's debt is about as big a thing as its war. We are only surprised that it being the duty of the people of the state to foster and build up a great metropolis within their own state lines, the legislature was not petitioned to pay the debt out of the state treasury.

In stating what it believes the next legislature should do, the San Sals News says: "We believe that the major force should be kept in the field and increased in numbers. This force has done more to bring criminals to grief and to preserve peace and order throughout the country than all the posse officers in the state. A sufficient number of posse officers should be kept on the frontier to protect its citizens from the depredations of our thieving red brothers, and, in case of emergency, where the posse officers are unable to enforce the laws, this force should be recruited in the desired help but when the posse officers neglect or refuse to do their duty, we think they should be fined, and, if necessary, removed from office and others appointed who will see that the laws are enforced." The Express is "chuck by jaw" with the News on that proposition.

The St. Louis Republic refers to the Missouri letter business as follows: "The rumors that the prepared witness Lindsey, alias O'Brien, was the mere tool of republican conspirators, thrust into the case to make political capital against the democratic national committee, may be entirely true, but even that does not avail to clear up the appearance of fraud which are now stamped on the Kansas Chinese letter. Some time ago THE EXPRESS made editorial reference to an important enterprise contemplated by an English firm, in connection with the shipment of Texas horses and mules to the London market, and dwell at some length upon the good results to this section the success of such an enterprise would mean. A recent correspondence with Mr. M. J. Verkerken, the head of the firm, or at least the leading spirit in the movement, and who is now stopping at the Menger Hotel, in this city, more than ever convinced us of the importance of the contemplated scheme, if it can be put into successful operation. Mr. V. is largely interested in several street railway lines in London and different cities on the continent, and his line is to furnish stock for these lines from the prairie of Texas. His eye one line in London alone will require about two thousand horses or mules a year, and the other lines will require several thousand additional. He has great confidence in the value of that animal is greatly undervalued in England, and because of this lack of appreciation, shippers of mules to England have almost invariably lost money by the transaction. A big expense he purchased a few to make an experiment for the satisfaction of his company, and the present scheme was the result. He is now visiting the country to make himself acquainted with the resources in the way of good ponies and half-Spanish mules, and will make a trial shipment in a few months. He finds plenty of the animals desired here, and if the first shipment proves satisfactory, his company will regularly issue the business to supply their own demands. It is intention to purchase two and three year old stock, from their well up for about two years, and then ship them, it not being the intention to put any animal to work under about five years old.

Our people should give this gentleman every encouragement in this matter, for it contemplates the establishing of a business that will bring many thousands of dollars to this section annually, and furnish a good market for a class of stock that are often going begging for purchasers. Besides the purchase of the stock, their care and handling will give employment to quite a number of persons, and a demand will also be made for a large supply of forage for the animals while they are being prepared for shipment. If the business should be carried on to the extent now proposed, it would bring over \$100,000 annually from London to be scattered among the people of western Texas, and the price is well worth contending for. We can easily supply the demand for years to come if we have a reasonable knowledge of what the demand will be, and we have no doubt the business would be mutual as between the buyers and sellers.

Big Sale of Short Horses. Week before last there was an extensive sale of short-horn cattle at Kansas City, there being a spirited competition and big prices realized for the best cattle. We did not notice the names of many Texans among the buyers, though Dickell & Sons were the heaviest bidders in the market, their purchases being sent to their ranch in the Pan Handle. Referring to this sale the Kansas City Price Current says: "Messrs. Dickell & Sons, who were the largest buyers of bulls, paid good prices for everything they bought, but took only the best animals. Experience has taught them that a good bull is worth all the premiums he brings over an inferior one. Few cannot raise good stock in grade and plainly bred animals. Dickell has always bought the best bulls and pedigreed ones; not that the pedigree was worth anything to him in crossing upon Texas cows, but he couldn't obtain the good individual from a reliable breeder without the pedigree. What has been the result? He brings to our market the best half-bred cattle, and the prices realized are 50 cents per cwt. higher than obtained by those ranchmen who use grades or cheap short-horn. The vast difference in the market value of the produce of pedigreed bulls and grades is causing buyers to learn better their true value, and discriminate more between them each year."
