Washington, February 1.—The finance committee to-day agreed to amend the house funding bill so as to make bonds redeemable in five years, and payable in two years from their date of issue, and to fix the rate of interest at three and one-half per cent.

The fourth, fifth and sixth sections of the bill were not reached for action to-day. Morgan, from committee on the state law in regard to the electoral count, reported back his report on that subject with an amendment...
