School Organization.

As trustees of the St. John's school community, No. 16, we wish to inform our patterns and friends that the school organization for the present scholastic year has been duly effected. The teacher's contract has been executed and the business of the school inaugurated from the 1st of September. Our registered list, as carefully made out, demands the pro-ruta for 121 children, which will give us \$387.20.

We deem it our duty, as guardians of the public school money, to make a statement of the powers given us by the school law and of the manner which we have chosen for contracting with the teacher. It is expressly stated in the school law that the contract shall specify a certain attendance of children at school, otherwise, the contract cannot be approved or recorded by the county judge. Either seventy-five per cent of the registered children must attend during the month, or the teacher may be paid, according to the actual number of children attending the school. We have dec'ded on the latter course, having determined at the outset, to suspend the operations of the school whenever the average daily attendance falls below lifteen children. If this lies between fifteen and twenty-five and not passing forty, \$45. and dren. If this lies between fifteen and twenty-five we pay \$30 per month, beyond twenty-five and not passing forty, \$45, and should it exceed forty, the teacher may have the services of an assistant at a salary which we shall determine, when necessary. Under this arrangement, there cannot, possibly, be misappropriation or fraud, nor can the teacher justly complain, as he gets paid for the actual work done by him. Of course we shall be responsible that the daily attendances are properly marked and other details of the law fatthfully carried out.

We carnestly desire the co-operation of the parents and grardians of children in our community, by cucouraging their attendance and application, being convinced that it is only by this means, we may be enabled to accomplish the hopes entertained from the beginning, of establishing on a permanent basis a successful and useful school.
