She took a chair, and though somewhat nervous, had no particular objection to using chloroform. Her husband assisted me in giving it, and when she was under the induence of the anesthetic I easily extracted the tooth. She presently revived, and sat up in the chair with the remark that she was glad it was over. She added that she felt the operation, but it gave her no pain. I began gathering up my toola, and none of us paid any particular attention to Mrs. Pitch. In a few moments she started zeross the room, At this instant, with hardly a murmun, she sank on the floor, and almost before we could reach her, was dead."
