Mrs. Mary Callaghan testified as follows:
I am the wife of the deceased. My husband came home this evening, February 6, 1882, about 6 or 6:30 o'clock. When my husband came I believe he took a strink, and he gave me money to buy some articles, and said he was going to see Mr. Dwyer about going to the theatre, and did not care about going. A few minutes after that my husband called me and said he was going to shoot himself. I begged him not to, and he sat down in the stable, and then shot himself. My husband is about 33 or 34 years of age and a native of San Antonlo,

he was dead, the body lying in a stable, with pixtol in hand. The hall had antered the lower portion of the frontal bone, inflicting a deadly wound. It is my opinion that Mr. James Callaghan came to his death from a gun-shot wound inflicted by his own hand.
