



The doctrine of local assessments as prescribed in our charter is not only legal but just and equitable; in fact, should an effort be made to change it, so that street improvements should be made by issuing city bonds and thereby taxing the entire city, we are sure the efforts would fail, as the legislature could, not and would not grant it, being not only unconstitutional but in direct conflict with the well-set-tied principles of municipal law. Whenever the property owners are designous of improving the street upon which they live, or are interested in, the city council will really co-operate with them; and until such a spirit is shown by them, it is very unright to complain of the want of enterprise in the mayor and board of aldermen.


