While we lament the fact that some of our citizens were so unfortunate as to have had their property so exposed, yet such misfortunes, in our opinion, cannot as a matter of public policy, and in justice to the large majority of taxpayers, be paid out of the city reasury.

Next to Newgate, in London, the Tombs prison has had the most remarkable history of any, and identified with it from her experience of thirty-six years was the matron, Miss Flora Foster, who died on Tuesday last. She was a woman of low stature, stont, build, full features, healthy color and of tireless energy. She had vigorous common sense, a hearty, womanly way and a humane and genebous disposition. Harsh and rude as were her surroundings, they never spoiled her temper or made her less sensitive to sorrow and suffering. In her time she took charge of thousands of women and young girls and children, from all grades of life, and she witnessed more misery and degradation than falls to the ordinary experience. She freely gave of her limited means to help unfortunate women, and by her wise and kindly advice many a young girl was stopped on her way downward to ruin. Though without the rude strength of the average masculine keeper or policeman, she has been known to control the most violent prisoners when none others could. All the people connected with the Tombs were in great sorrow yesterday over her death, and Deputy Warden Mark Finley, who has been in the prison almost as long as Miss Foster, was completely prostrated. Warden Finn, too, was vishly affected, and, though the atmosphere outside was bright and full of sanshine, the Tombs was more than usually gloomy. N. Y. Herald.
