



PALESTINE.

Special Correspondence.

PALESTINE, March 13.—The wondrous growth of the city of Palestine within the past half decade, from 1,500 to 5,000 people, has so surprised your correspondent, who has just stopped here on his round trip from Chicago to the bridge celebration at Laredo, that he deems it a pleasure from the fact of its being his Texas home to express his gratification at its substantial prosperity. 
