STATE NEWS.

LEGISLATIVE PROCEEDINGS.

Governor Brown in Defense of Railroads.

Gov. Brown, in his address to the Legislature, defended the railroads against the charges of monopoly and abuse of power. He stated that the railroads were essential to the state's commerce and that the government should regulate them for the benefit of the public.
