



Among the Farmers of the West-Crop Prospects-How Mistakes are Made -Some Advice to be Treas-

Special Correspondence.

Castroville, April 23.—While at the Sabinal, I called on Mr. Kennedy, and took a look at his pretty little farm of forty acres. I wrote you last year that Mr. Kennedy made twenty-five bushels of corn to the acre. Uncle John this year took Greeley's advice and commenced planting his corn the 20th of January. It was bitten down the first of March. He got scared and talked about plowing it up. His wife told him to wait a while. He did so, and it all came out again, and to-day it is the finest field of corn I have seen. He sustains Greeley in early planting, but he had not thinned and hoed his corn as I told him. Most all farmers have their corn too thick.

Uncle John's corn was knee high, although about all the work it had was simply to run around it with a bull tongue plow, leaving a little dich three inches deep on each side of the corn to give the sun and hot air a chance to absorb the moisture from the roots of his corn. If day blades folded, I told him the cause was failing to plow out his corn thoroughly and level, and leave not open furrows at the root of his corn. He agreed with me, but sand he had no cultivator, except a small, one-horse expanding cultivator. I told him to use that,

I saw ten acres of oats sown in October, that he had grazed his bucks—thirty in number—on for two months; also, about one hundred and twenty early lambs. 
