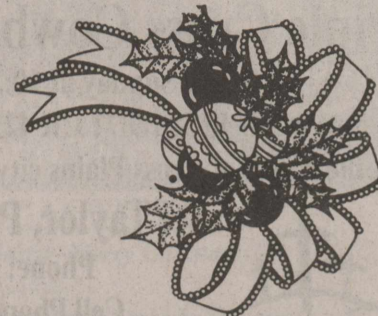

## Cross Plains Public Library Receives Grant to Digitize Firestorm Scrapbook

The Cross Plains Public Library has received a grant from the Burdine Johnson Foundation in Buda, TX, to digitize the scrapbook containing pictures and articles about the December 2005 Firestorm that hit our community.

The library holds the original and only album containing a compilation of pictures taken immediately afterward, newspaper reports, memoirs from residents, and commentary.

Because they are valuable to our history, we do not allow patrons to check the book out—

they must view it in the library—which limits our audience. We are delighted that local author and historian Ann Beeler (*Footsteps of Approaching Thousands*) is willing to digitize our scrapbook.

The library is completing the paperwork to partner with the Portal to Texas History of the University of North Texas Libraries' Digital Projects Unit to post the digitized items on their website so that they will be available to everyone.

## Candlelight Service Christmas Eve at Presbyterian Church in Cross Plains

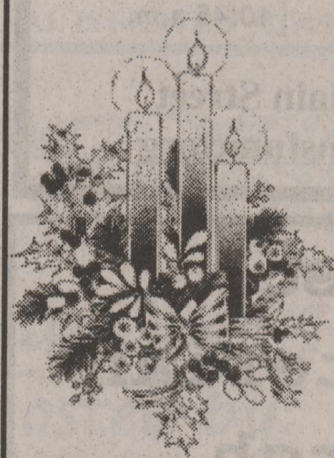

## 2012 Callahan County Holiday Schedule set

The Callahan County Commissioners voted to approve the 2012 holiday schedule during the commissioners' court regular meeting held Monday, December 12th at the County Courthouse in Baird.

On a motion by Commissioner Bryan Farmer and second by Commissioner Tom Windham, the commissioners' court voted 4-0 to approve the 2012 County Holiday Schedule. Commissioner Harold Hicks abstained from voting on the motion.

The 2012 holiday schedule for county employees include:

Other agenda items brought before the commissioners' court included:

—Callahan County Judge Roger Corn called the commissioners' court meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. with Precinct #1 Commissioner Harold Hicks, Precinct #2 Commissioner Bryan Farmer, Precinct #3 Commissioner Tom Windham, and Precinct #4 Commissioner Cliff Kirkham present. Also present at the meeting were Donna Bell,

County Clerk, and County Treasurer Dianne Gunter.

—The commissioners' court meeting minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and signed.

—Under public comment, County Clerk Donna Bell discussed with the commissioners' court that the City of Clyde has suggested that Early Voting be held at Clyde City Hall. This was suggested due to some of the cities joining the county in their elections and the cities being required to be open for 12 hours two days of early voting. No action was taken.

—Katie Dunn with the Callahan County Nutrition Project brought before the commissioners' court the problems she is

having with getting software installed in her computer. No action was taken.

—Commissioner Hicks made a motion to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Abilene Regional Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, Inc. Commissioner Windham seconded the motion. The motion carried with a vote of 5-0.

—No action was taken on the Countywide Burn Ban. The Countywide Burn Ban remains lifted.

—Sheriff John Windham presented the Callahan County Sheriff's Office Monthly Report for the month of November. Commissioner Kirkham made the motion to approve the report. Commissioner Farmer sec-

onded the motion and the motion carried with a 5-0 vote.

—Commissioner Windham made a motion to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Putnam. Commissioner Kirkham seconded the motion and the motion carried with a 5-0 vote.

—Commissioner Windham made a motion to pay the approved bills. Commissioner Windham seconded the motion and the motion passed with a vote of 5-0.

—Commissioner Windham made a motion to adjourn the commissioners' court meeting at 10:18 a.m. Commissioner Hicks seconded the motion and the motion was approved with a vote of 5-0.

## Commissioners approve order prohibiting the use of fireworks in Callahan County

The Callahan County commissioners' court approved an order prohibiting the use of certain fireworks in unincorporated areas of Callahan County during the commissioners' court meeting held Monday, December 12th at the County Courthouse in Baird.

On a motion by Commissioner Bryan Farmer and a second by Commissioner Cliff Kirkham, the commissioners' court voted 5-0 to prohibit the use of certain fireworks for the Christmas holiday period.

On the 12th day of December, 2011, the Commissioners' Court of Callahan County adopted the following order effective immediately:

### ORDER PROHIBITING USE OF FIREWORKS IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CALLAHAN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist in Cal-

lahan County; and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of December, 2011, the Commissioners' Court of Callahan County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Callahan County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners' Court of Callahan County adopts this Order prohibiting the use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Callahan County.

A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified under 49 C.F.R. part 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as "skyrockets with sticks, and "Missiles with fins" in any portion of the unincorporated area of Callahan County.

B. This Order does not prohibit:

1. Common fireworks, small in size classified as Class C explosives.
2. Large fireworks devices designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and classified as Class B explosive by the U.S. Dept. of Transportation (TEX. OCC. CODE, Chapter 2154).
3. The sale of "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins."

C. This order does not prohibit "permissible fireworks" as authorized in Occupations Code Section 2154.003(a).

D. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C Misdemeanor.

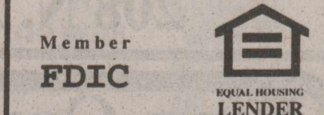
## Keepsake Calendars NOW on Sale

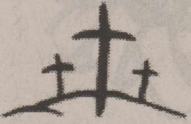

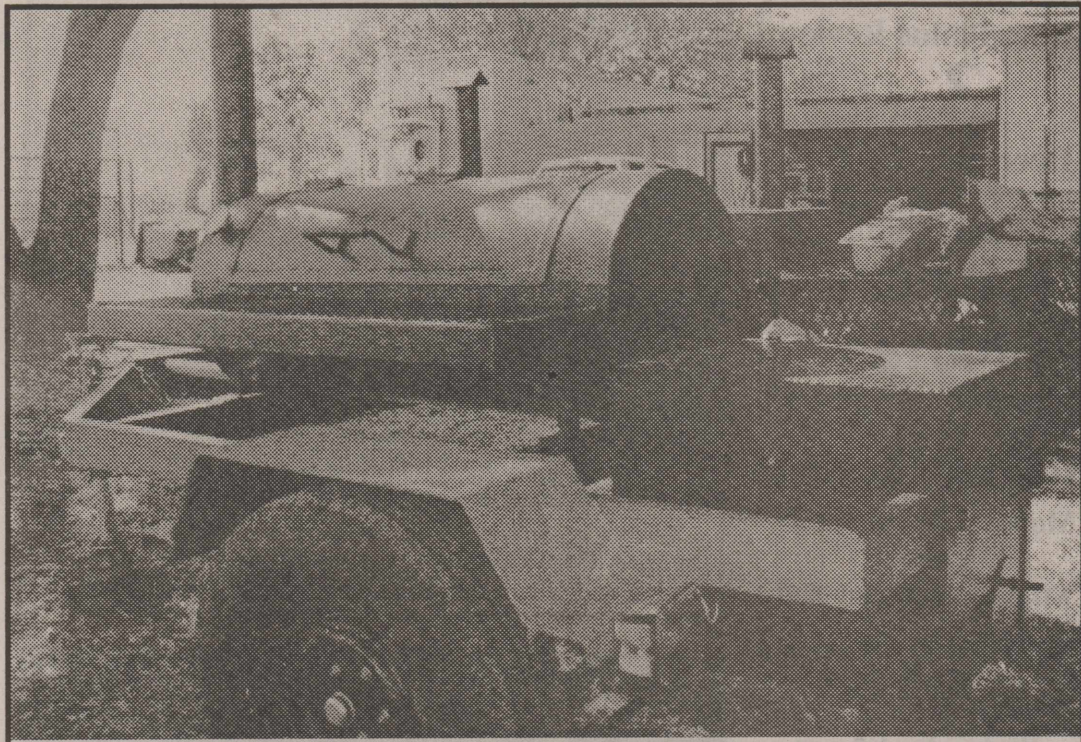

## Commissioner Staples awards \$150,000 to 15 young Texas Farmers

(AUSTIN) In an effort to sustain Texas' standing as a powerhouse of agricultural productivity, Agriculture Commissioner Todd Staples today announced the Texas Agricultural Finance Authority (TAFA) has awarded \$150,000 in the form of matching grants to 15 young farmers.

The funds, in the amount of \$10,000 each, are awarded through the Young Farmer Grant Program to farmers ages 18-46 who will create or expand agricultural businesses in Texas. Texas farmers fund the program through farm vehicle registration fees.

"According to USDA, the

average age of a principal owner of a Texas farm or ranch is 59 years old with only 6 percent under the age of 35," Commissioner Staples said. "As today's farmers and ranchers near retirement, we must find ways to support a younger generation that will be tasked with feeding a growing population.

The Young Farmer Grant Program, which is funded entirely by Texas farmers and ranchers, offers user-friendly, effective financing options that can help new and young operators get started and become more firmly established.

In 2009, the 81st Texas Legislature approved the Texas Department of Agriculture's proposal for TAFA to establish the first-of-its-kind Young Farmer Grant Program. Since TAFA's creation in 1987, the program has provided financial assistance to individuals and businesses through partnerships with banks or other agricultural lending institutions.
