## Property Tax Protest and Appeal Procedures

## Usual Deadline

On or before April 30 for residence homesteads and May 31 for all other property (or within 30 days after a notice of appraised value was mailed to you, whichever is later).
Late protests are allowed if you miss the usual deadline for good cause. The ARB decides whether you have good cause.
For ARB changes (the ARB has informed you of a change that increases your tax liability and the change did not result from a protest you filed), the deadline is not later than the 30 th day after the notice of the change was delivered to you. (You may insert deadline for protests concerning omitted property if doing so would avoid taxpayer confusion. Special Deadlines
iFor change of use (the appraisal district informed you that you are losing agricultural appraisal
because you changed the use of your land), the deadline is not later than the 30th day after

Ashbel Smith became father of University of Texas For deqades, the University of
Texas has stood as a leader in Texas and the nation for research and education. It has produced
countless scholars as well as spirited rivalries in sporting contests since its inception. The creation
of the university, however, took of the university, however, took

Ashbel Smith. Smith was born in Hartford,
Connecticut, in 1805. He attended the local public schools where he had an unquenchable thirst

from Yale University at age 19. He then taught school in North Carolina before returning to Yale
to earn a medical degree. to earn a medical degree. He came to Texas in 1836,
and in 1837, Sam Houston named him the first surgeon general of the Texas Army. Smith immediately instituted an
advanced system of sanitation advanced system of sanitation
and established the first hospital and established th.
in Harris County.
He also served as a respected
diplomat, negotiating peace with the Comanches in 1842
and also serving as the Texas and also serving as the Texas
ambassador to Great Britain ambassador to Great Britain
and France. He also served as
the last Secretary of State for the last Secretary of State for
the Republic of Texas. Smith served three terms in the state
legislature and co-founded the legislature and co-founded the

he helped establish the Texas
