Christmas play leaves 'em laughin'

An Italian voice teacher stole the show Thursday during Lazbuddie Elementary School's annual Christmas program.

Robby Martin had the crowd and fellow performers in hysterics during the fourth and fifth graders production of "Santa Sings the Blues" with his portrayal of Vittorio Vivace, an eccentric Italian voice teacher and maker of stars.

"They were laughing so hard they had tears in their eyes when they came off stage," said fourth-grade teacher Tanya Steinbock.

The 45-minute musical follows the path of Santa Claus (Kolby Wilkerson), who hits the road in search of singing stardom. Vivace turns him into Willy Vanilli, an up-and-coming rockabilly star. But not before promising Mrs. Claus (Shonnah Black) that he'll return before Christmas.

But Santa gets the homesick blues during a whirlwind tour.

During a shopping mall performance in Sowbelly, USA, Willy Vanilli reveals his true identity, and sings of

the true meaning of Christmas in a song called "Stop, look and listen to all you've been missing."

The message is that the spirit of Christmas may be found in music and friends, not in shopping.

DALHART — Dalhart couldn't handle Dustin Cleavinger and Douglass Field inside.

Cleavinger collected 25 points and 12 rebounds and Field scored 16 points in the second half and overtime, leading Muleshoe to a 66-64 win over Dalhart Friday in the District 1-3A opener for both teams.

Field scored 12 points in the second half, including a short shot with two seconds left that sent the game into overtime tied at 57.

Muleshoe (12-5) has more than doubled their win total from last year (5-23) and is thinking playoffs.

"The more we win, the more the kids believe," Muleshoe coach Ralph Mason said. "Their goal is to make the playoffs. Regardless if people think it is realistic goal, that's their goal."

"It's a good feeling to have this kind of success with such a young team," Mason added with a big smile.

Josh Reynolds led Dalhart (10-4, 0-1) with 19 points. Cody Copeland and Rodolfo Barron each added 11 points.

The Mules rallied from a 9-point deficit in the fourth quarter and trailed 57-55 with five seconds left.

Running a play set up during a timeout, Matt Mason (4 points, 8 assists) drove the baseline and dumped the ball down to Field on the block. Field scored and was fouled. But his free throw to win the game in overtime bounced off the back iron.

Field scored four points in overtime, including the basket that put Muleshoe in the lead for good. Cleavinger and Field scored 8 of Muleshoe's 9 points in overtime.

"They didn't do a good job of keeping us from getting the ball into the post," Mason said. "And once we go it inside, they couldn't stop us."

New class features hands-on training

Local students are getting a headstart on a career in the medical field.

Eight students at Muleshoe High School recently completed on-site training at Muleshoe Area Healthcare Center. It was their latest step in becoming certified nurses aides.

Students must pass a Texas Department of Human Services written test to become a nures aide.

The students' journey toward becoming a certified nurses aide began last year, when they joined the new health occupations course being offered at MHS. The students spent their first year learning the basic rudiments of the health care field, such as medical terminology, proper sanitation procedures, and basic human anatomy.

The students who chose to undertake the second level of the health occupations course became more exposed to the world of health care. After

spending the first part of the semester in a classroom, the students began working on-site at the Muleshoe Area Healthcare Center.

Connie Weatherbie, class instructor, said that students were able to engage in all the activities of a regular nurses aide, seeing to the everyday needs of the residents of the nursing home.

The students said that their

favorite part about working at the nursing home was the becoming acquainted with the patients.

"I like just talking with them," senior Kristi Bennett said. "They have a lot to say."

Weatherbie said that the second semester of the course will give the students even more opportunities to gain first-hand

Rainbow popcorn balls

1 cup light corn syrup
1/2 cup sugar
1 package (3 oz.) Gelatin
Dessert (any flavor)
1/2 lbs. salted peanuts, coarsely chopped
9 cups popped popcorn
Combine syrup and sugar and bring to a boil. Remove form heat. Add gelatin and stir until dissolved. Add peanuts and pour over popcorn, mixing well. Shape into 1-1/2 inch balls. Makes about 4 dozen. These may be wrapped in cellophane or waxed paper, if desired. Store in tightly covered container.

Snacktime Fun For The Holidays
Raw fruits and vegetables served with a yogurt dip seasoned with Seasoning Salt, Italian Herb Mix or others.

Homemade whole-grain bread with apple butter.

Unsalted seeds and/or nuts; serve with soy sauce.

Dried fruit or vegetables slices (example- zucchini slices).

Cubes of processed cheese with pretzel stick "handles."

Waffle sandwich; use left-over waffles from breakfast to make a nutritious afternoon snack. Fill waffle sandwiches with fruit-flavored yogurt. Freeze.

"Jaw Breakers"- Freeze grapes or red sweet cherries and melon balls. These are a delicious treat.

Apple Pinwheel. Core an apple and stuff the opening with peanut butter, cream cheese or cheese spread. Chill and slice crosswise to serve.

Spread peanut butter snack crackers. Melt 12 oz. chocolate chips (or butterscotch chips) with 1/2 block paraffin in top of double boiler. Dip crackers and cool on wax paper.

The couple is survived by two daughters, Barbara Thomas of Gaithersburg, Md., Linda Karr of Starkville Miss., two sons, Shelley Jones of Brookings, Ore., and Kirby Jones of Sacramento, Calif., seven grandchildren and one great grandchild.

Mr. Jones is also survived by two brothers, Wayne of Louise, Texas, Bryan of La Habra, Calif., two sisters, Juanita Hyatt of Amarillo, and Virginia Hyde of Plainview.

Pickin's were slim. Every evening the man would stake the last burro out down below the spring to graze. During the day he went with the man and packed mud or water or rocks or wood.

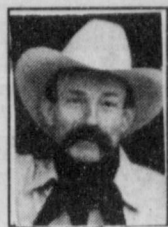

"It gave the students a chance to learn about different cultures," said third-grade teacher Cindy Furr.

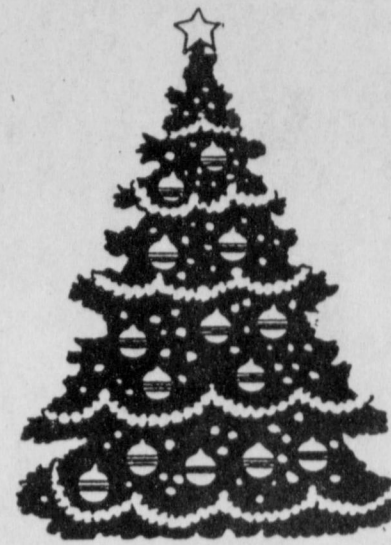

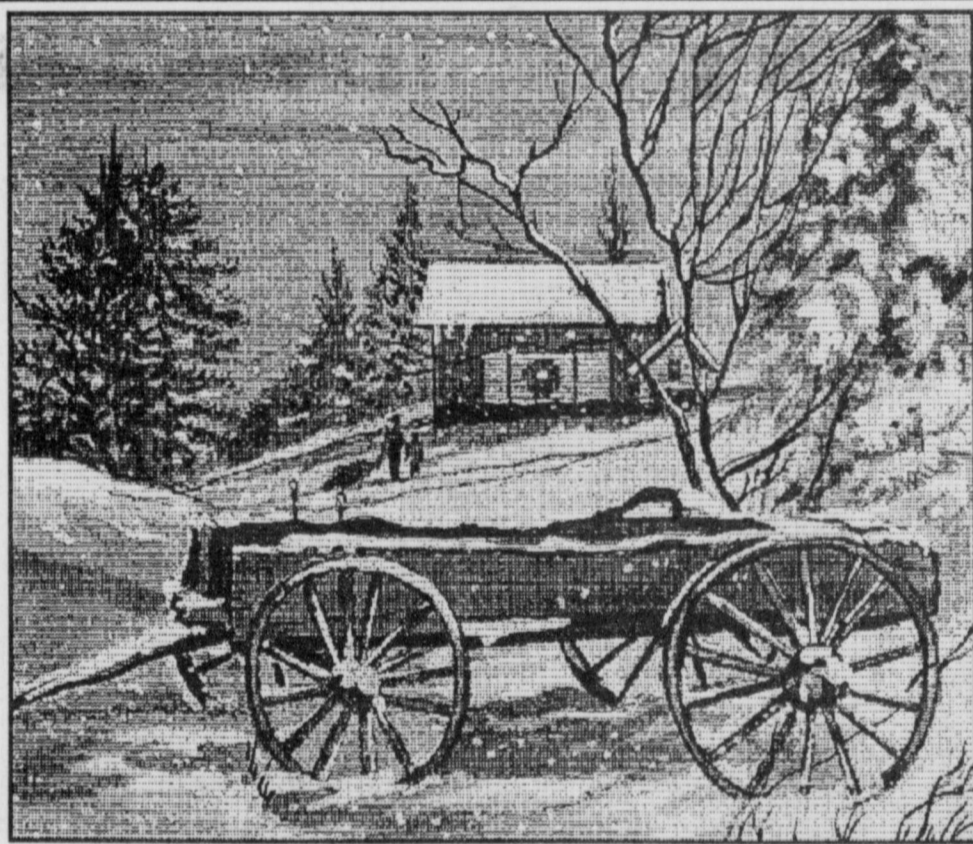

Foul trouble dooms MHS at Dalhart

DALHART — Muleshoe coach Jim Gruhlkey felt as empty as his bench was at the end of the game.

Dalhart took advantage of Muleshoe's foul troubles Friday to hand the Lady Mules a 49-44 loss in a District 1-3A game Friday.

Four Lady Mules fouled out in the fourth quarter when Dalhart rallied from a five-point deficit to hand the Lady Mules (5-11, 2-1) their first district loss. Muleshoe played the last six seconds with only four players.

The Lady Mules also played most of the game without Kristen Nichols, who hurt her ankle in the second quarter.

"It was miserable," Gruhlkey said. "We didn't play well by any means, but I thought we'd be able to get out of there alive."

But Dalhart (8-6, 2-1) outscored Muleshoe 19-9 in the fourth quarter.

Point guard Tashia Washington scored 7 points in the fourth quarter, including a back-breaking 3-pointer and 4 of 6 free throws. She finished with 12 points. Amber Porter added 5 of her team-high 16 points in the quarter, including 3 of 4 free throws.

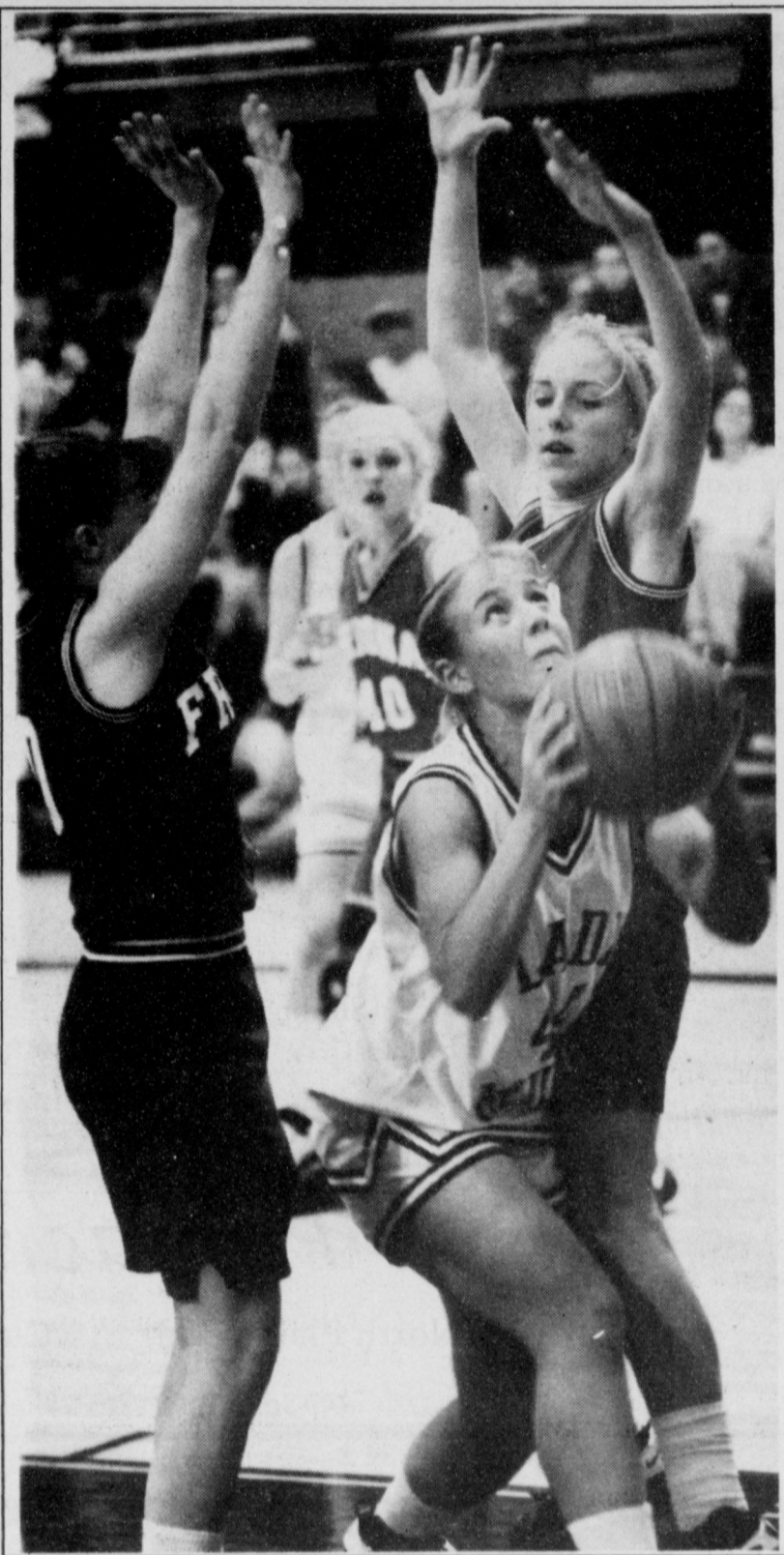
Lindsey Field led Muleshoe with 17 points, but made just 11 of 20 free throws. The Lady Mules were just 19 of 36 from the free throw line.

Brandi Harrison added 9 points for Muleshoe. Harrison sat out most of the first half after picking up two quick fouls and fouling out early in the fourth quarter.

River Road, which routed Dimmitt 70-54 Friday, leads the district with a 3-0 record heading into Christmas break.

Muleshoe is in a four-way tie for second.
