TREES SAVE SOIL WATER.
Windbreaks Prevent Excessive Evaporation in Dry Lands.

A hedge fifteen to eighteen feet high will evaporate the soil moisture in its vicinity. On the leeward side the evaporation of moisture is lessened to a considerable distance from the hedge and close up to the windward side the windward side.
