A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Texas as to permit the accounting officers of this State to draw and pay warrants for salaries to officers of the United States Army or Navy...

Section 1. That Section 33 of Article 16 of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. The accounting officers of this State shall neither draw nor pay a warrant upon the Treasury in favor of any person, for salary or compensation as agent, officer or appointee, who holds at the same time any other office or position of honor, trust or profit under this State or the United States...

Section 3. The Governor of the State of Texas is hereby directed to issue the necessary proclamation for said election and have the same published as required by the Constitution...

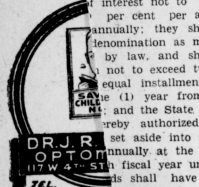

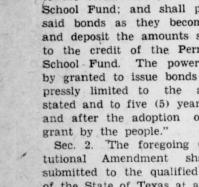
