



## The Lowly Prune

Another of a series of articles being written for The Journal on similar subjects by Mrs. Gerald Moore, teacher of Home Economics in the Muleshoe high school.

The lowly prune, which used to be referred to in slang phrases of contempt, is in good standing with nutritionists and its popularity with consumers also is increasing since some very tasty and attractive dishes can be prepared from the prune.

On the nutrition side of the picture, experts point out that the prune is a good source of vitamin A and a fair source of vitamins B and C. It also contains a fair amount of calcium and is a good source of iron.

Here are some ways to use prunes in tasty dishes.

### Prunes In Salads

Combine 1 cup cut prunes with 2 cups diced raw apple, or with 1 cup shredded raw cabbage and 1 cup shredded raw carrots. Use sufficient well seasoned dressing to moisten, and mix lightly.

### Prunes In Sandwiches

Mix chopped, cooked prunes with cottage cheese, with peanut butter, or with a little chopped onion. Spread on bread for sandwiches. For hot sandwiches combine 1 1/2 cups chopped, cooked prunes with 1-2 cup grated cheese, and season with salt to taste. Make sandwiches and brown them on both sides in a little hot fat, or spread the prune and cheese filling between slices of hot toast.

### Prune And Apple Betty

1 cup cooked prunes.  
4 or 5 cooking apples.  
2 cups bread crumbs.  
Fat.

1-2 cup liquid in which prunes were cooked.  
1-4 cup sugar.

Put prunes and cut into large pieces. Pare apples and slice very thin. Heat fat in frying pan, add apples and bread crumbs and fry and stir until apples are slightly

tender. Add prunes, salt to taste, liquid and sugar and cook and stir until apples are entirely tender. Serve hot or cold, plain or with milk.

### Prune Cake

3 cups soaked prunes, chopped.  
2 cups brown sugar.  
2 cups boiling water.  
3 cups sifted flour.  
1-2 teaspoon soda.  
4 tablespoons fat.  
1 teaspoon salt.  
2 teaspoons baking powder.

(Cinnamon, or other spices may be added, if desired.)  
Mix the sugar, water, prunes and salt, boil for 2 minutes and add the fat. Cool. Sift the baking powder, soda, and spices, with the flour and stir into the first mixture. Pour into a pan lined with greased paper and bake in a very moderate oven for one hour. As with other cakes made with brown sugar, this cake will tend to scorch if the oven is too hot.

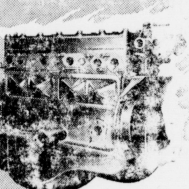

## Sidelights From Washington

By law Congress has given veterans priority rights in the purchase of surplus government property. But the veteran has not been having much luck in actually getting a chance to buy this surplus property. Some time ago, I joined with other increased Members of Congress in urging and demanding that the Surplus Property Board make available to the veteran his legal preference to acquire surplus property.

Effective October 15th, a new procedure was put into operation whereby a veteran who desires to

secure surplus property makes application to the nearest District Office of the Smaller War Plants Corporation for the items he wishes to buy. The SWPC offices which are nearest western Texas are located at the Merchantile Building, Dallas; The Caples Building, El Paso; and the Key Building in Oklahoma City. The SWPC grants a priority certificate to the veteran and seeks to help locate the property for him.

Effective November 5th, surplus property in Texas is actually disposed of by the Reconstruction Finance Corporation, Surplus Property Division, Nell P. Anderson Building, Fort Worth, Texas.

Heavy machinery and industrial equipment are disposed of by the Regional RFC office, Cotton Exchange Building, Dallas. But the Fort Worth office handles all consumer type goods—the items in which veterans and people generally are interested.

The articles in which veterans have expressed the greatest interest are as follows, and in the order named: Automobiles, trucks, radios, photographic equipment. One stumbling block in the way of veterans who have sought to buy surplus property is the fact that federal agencies, the states and subdivisions thereof, have a prior right to buy the property. The veteran will now have priority over the general public but not over governmental agencies.

Veterans will soon have much better opportunities to acquire the property in which they are interested and which many of them have sought in vain to secure.

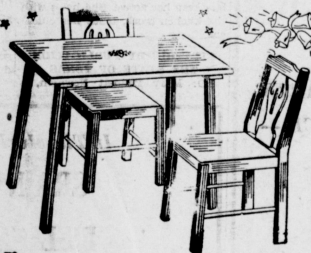

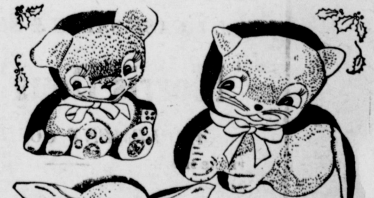

# NOV. 21, 1945

- Option to retire at half pay for the rest of your life after 20 years' service—or three-quarters pay after 30 years. (Retirement income in grade of Master or First Sergeant up to \$155.25 per month for life.) All previous active federal military service counts toward retirement.

- Family allowances for the term of enlistment for dependents of men who enlist or reenlist before July 1, 1946.

They have a train running from Pearl Harbor to Honolulu about one half the size of our trains in the U. S. It carries passengers into town. There are hundreds of city buses running from the Navy yard to Honolulu and one can hardly get to Honolulu on one of them because they are so crowded.

We have an airport bus that comes to the base and turns back here or we would never get to town. The cars and trucks are as thick as flies. They are all full of soldiers and sailors hanging all over them.

Sometimes there will be 50 ships come into the harbor with from 500 of them.

At times there are about a dozen Army and Navy bases on this rock. At one place, there are more than two thousand fighter planes they can put in the air at just the word to go.

Just outside our gate is the civilian housing area. All the war workers sleep there. They are long barracks with hundreds of men in them. There must be a thousand barracks of them. All of this is around Honolulu. On the other side of the rock, there is Navy and Marine amphibious training; on the other side of this rock and Honolulu is the town they come to. One can hardly

get into a cafe. You can't imagine what it is like. I guess that is enough for now.

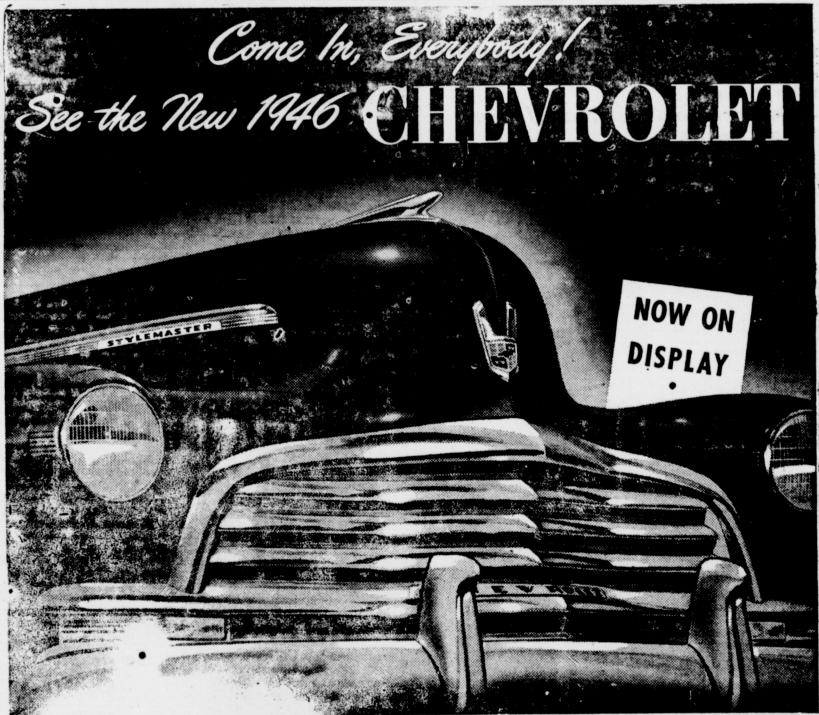

**Fat Pork Means More Calories**

How do you like pork? Some like it fat, of course, and some like it lean. But the fat pork makes a difference in the food value, according to Mrs. Laurette Wilson, County home demonstration agent of Bailey County.

The Bureau of Animal Industry of the United States Department of Agriculture has just finished the study of the difference in food value and composition between heavier hogs and lighter ones.

Mrs. Wilson reports the scientists found that as hogs get heavier, each of the cuts from those hogs also gains weight. Hams, shoulders,

bacon, and back fat all get heavier at about the same rate, pound for pound. The loin does not gain weight quite as fast. That is because the loin contains mostly lean meat. It means that the composition of most of the cuts changes as hogs get fat. They pick up a larger per cent of fat.

Now as for the food value, Mrs. Wilson says the pork from heavier hogs supplies us with more calories which in turn provides energy.

On the other hand, as hogs gain weight, the per cent of body-building protein content we get from meat goes down. It goes down faster in bacon than in any of the other cuts, but all the cuts show a drop in the protein content as hogs get fatter.

Now the question is, do you want meat from fatter hogs, or lighter ones? In the long run, the consum-
