## A City Ordinance

Creating Building Regulationswand Establishing a Fire District.

## t ordained by the City Council of the City

 Hermleigh, Texas that:ion 1. Fire Limits:

- The peoxisions of thig ordinance shall apply to ${ }^{\circ}$ be co-extensive with the territory and the boundaries now ignated, or which may hereafter be established as the fire its of the City of Hermleigh,except such provisions as are special reference made applicable to att the territory within corporate limits of said city, and the said fire limits as now ablished are hereby declared to be as follows:
East half of block 37; East half of block 44; all of block all of block 36; all of block 35 ; all of Dlock 46; West half of lock 47 ; West half of block 34 . ildings to be Altered: No wall structure, buildi No wall structure, building, or onstructed in the City of Hermigh except in conformity with e provisions of this ordinance o building already erected or all be raised, altered, removed haill upon in any manner that ould be in violation of any of he provisions of this ordinance,
r the approval issued there-


## Permits Required:

Refore the erection, construc ion, or alteration of any buildg , structure, or wall, or of any taging or flooring to be used for taiding or seating purpose or agent of either, or the lessee ect or builder employed by such wner or lessee in the connection tion, shall appty to the Builtring Inspector for a permit to do such
work.
Structures hereafter erected without permit, or not in conformity with this ordinance, shall be removed.
No building shall be removed until a permit has been obtained from the Building Inspector: and such of ficials shall not issue such proposed new location of the building would seriously increase the fire hazard of the surrounding buildings.
Each building permit shall re cite this section
Section 4. Permissable Wooden Structures Within Fire Limits:No wooden structures shall here after be built within the fire limits as given herein or as they may hereafter be established, ex cept the following: an all roofs placed upon such buildings or structures shall have an incombustible covering:

> (a) Temporary one
ing for use of builders.
ing for use of buliders. the long side, not over 15 feet the long side, not over 15 feet
high, with sides covered with incombustible material, and with an area not exceeding 500 square an area not exceeding
feet. A wooden fence shall not be used to form the back or side of such sheds.
(c) Wooden fences not over 10 feet high.
(d) Piazzas or balconies not exceeding 10 feet in width, extending more than 3 feet above the second-story floor beams. No such structure shall extend beyond the lot line, or be joined to any similar structure of another building.
(e) Small out houses not ex-
ceeding 150 spuare feet in area and 8 feet in height. Wooden sheds or outhouses shall not be located within 5 feet of any lot line, nor less than 30 feet from any other building over one story high.
No frame buildigg shall be moved from without to within the fire limits.
Building with wooden frame work clad with sheet metal, stuc coed, or veneered with brick, shall not be classed as frame buildings.
Section 5. Repairing Frame
Buildings Within Fire Limits:
Any exibit
within the exting frame building hereafter be damaged by fire decay or otherwise to an amount greater than one-third of its predation, shall not be rebuilt, but shall be removed.
Section 6. Walls:-
All exterior or divivion walls of building hereafter erected, shal be of sufficient thickness to support the load to be carried; but unreinforced concrete, or hollow block wall be less than 12 inches thick. Provided that, a permit may be issued for the re-errec brick walls, where the rarea is small and the hight not more than one-story, if in the juog. ment of the Building Inspector such thickness will provide satisfactory fireresistiveness for the occupancy involved.
Section 7. Moving Picture The-
The Building Inspector shall not grant a permit for the errection or alteration of any building to be used as a moving picture theater, or in which moving picthe corporation limit, unless the plans and specifications for the installation and opera tion of said moving picture thea ter, or for the exhibition of mov ing pictures, shall conform to the rules and regulation promul for the the State Fire Marshal for the safegurding against fir and panic.
A. A copy of said rules and regulations, as approved by the State Fire Mrshall, shall be kept on file by the City Secretary, and be subject to inspetion as a public document of the city. Section 8. Unsafe Buildings:Eevry building, structure, or part thereof, which shall appear to the Building Inspector to be dangerous, by reason of bad con dition of walls, defective construction, overloaded floors, lack
of guards agat fire or other causes, shall be Wist to be unsafe the Building Inspector shall immediately notify the owner or lessee to causemthe same to be made safe and shall also affix a notice of the danerous character made safe and shall also affix a
notice of the see whether or net it would really
not character of the structure in a conspicious glycerin was. spied, by a young calf briftingeandeneperson shall re ported to have pused a very yncommove or deface such notice so affixed; the owner or party having an interest in such unsafe building, or structure, being nofified thereof in writing by the Buildine Inspector. shall immediately cause the same to be made saie and secure; and if any such buiding shall be used for any purpose requiring a license ther for, the mayor may revoke said license on neglect of the owner to comply with the notice served as herein provided. When pub lic safety requires immediate ac tion, the Building Inspector may enter upon premises, with such
assistence as may be necessary, and cause the said structure be made secure or torn down and remnved without delay, at

Any and all persons who shall violate any of the previsions of the ordinance or fail to comply therewith. or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order or who shall build in vielation of any detailed statement of speci fications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any cer
tifieate or permit issued there
