Texas from babies to bankers were among those making the success of the annual Christmas Seal Sale their personal business a check-up on the anti-tuberculosis campaign financed by the seal sale revealed at headquarters here today.

Foreign-born residents, despite the peril and gloom over their native countries, are among those buying the colorful Christmas seals which symbolizes the fight America is making this month against the common enemy,

tuberculosis, on the home front. Despite the call for help from her "dear native England" one Shamrock, Texas, woman was among the first to send in a check for the Christmas seals she received in the mail as the drive opened last week. About her contribution, she said:

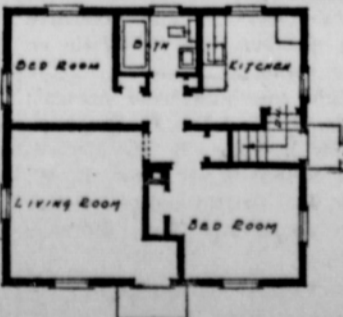
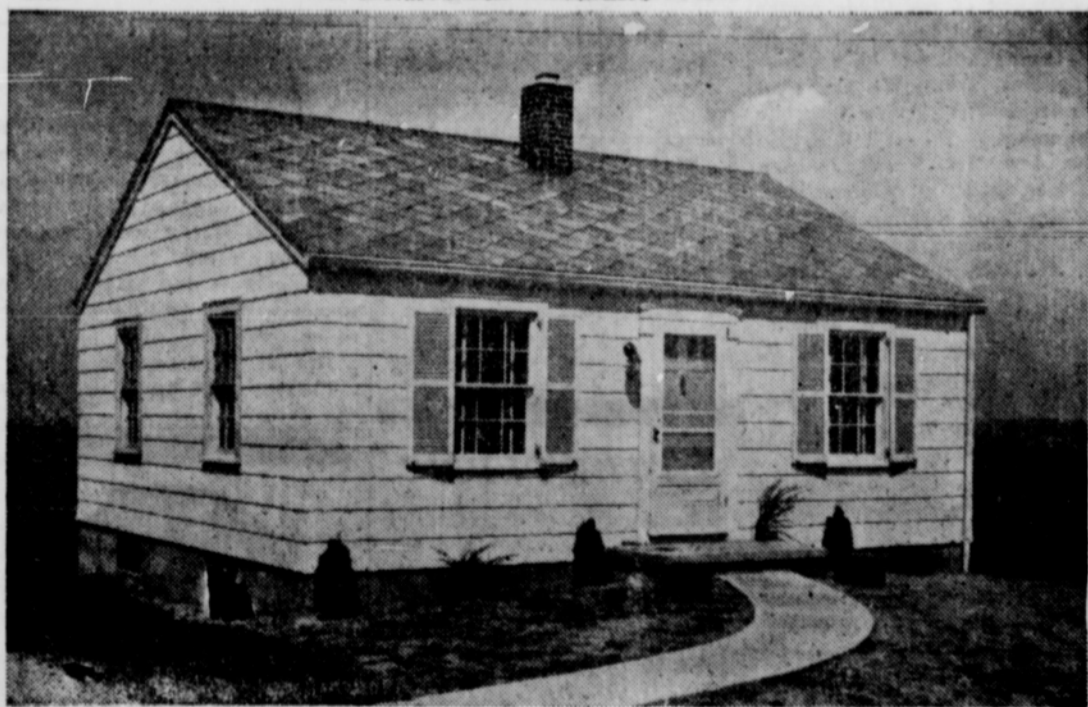
"I am sorry not to be able to keep them all (200 seals) but everyone has so many calls this time of the year, and our dear native England, through so brave needs all the help we can give. In enclose a check for \$1.50 which, I hope, will help a little. From Finland in the throes of

reconstruction following the soviet invasion comes well wishes from the tuberculosis association of that country with the brave note that "we are carrying on although we cannot expect such a brilliant result this year owing to the war."

China, battling for survival against the invaders, has managed to raise \$16,555 from its Christmas sale despite the turmoil of war, the Texas Tuberculosis Association here has been informed.
