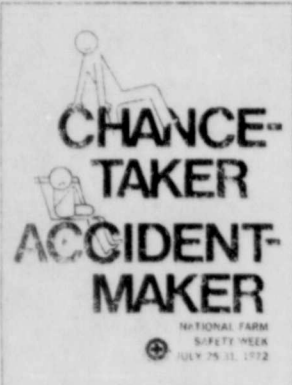
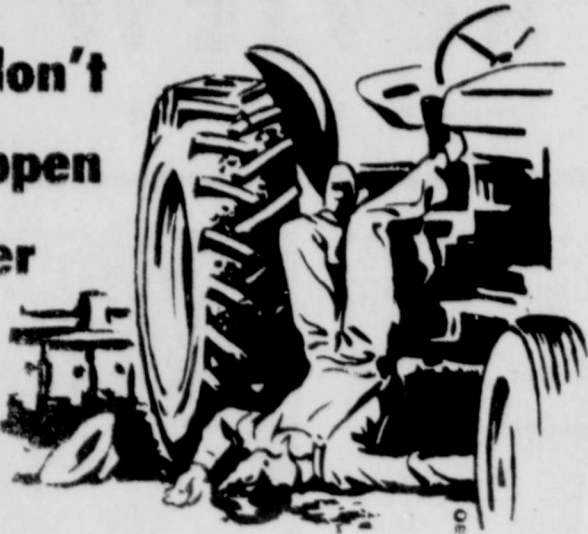

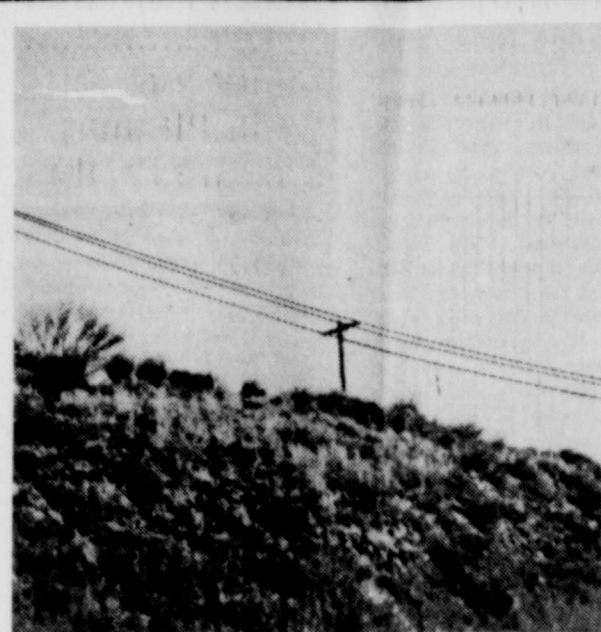
Bridal Shower Set For Miss Hardin

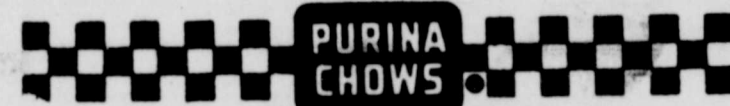

JOHNNY RAY WATSON TO SING AT FBC

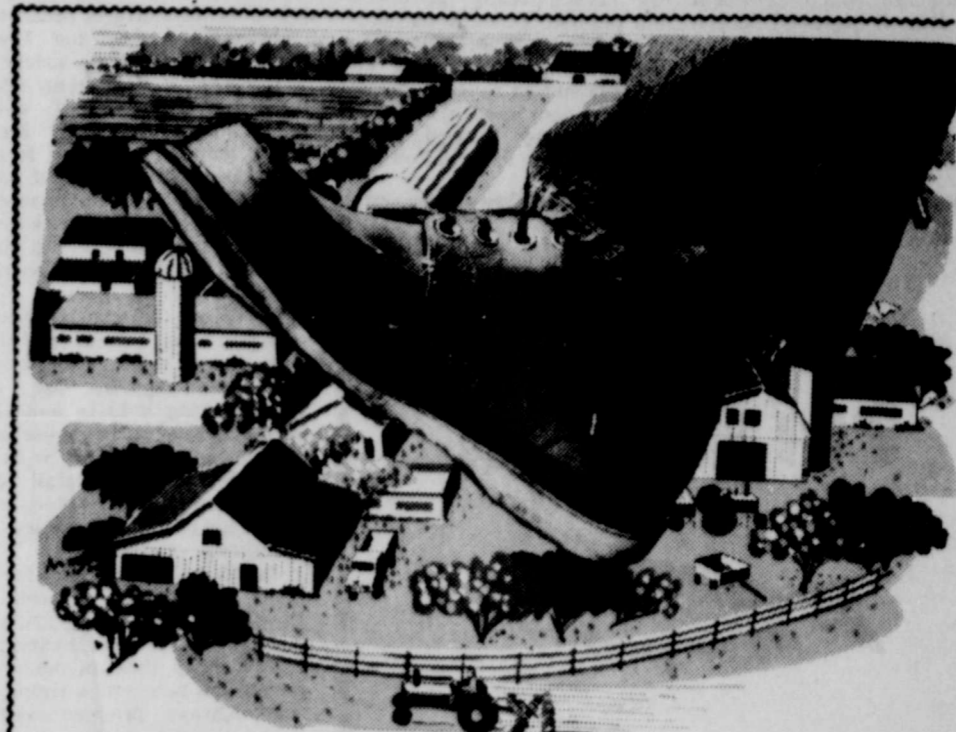

AUSTIN--Hale County farmers were the number one producers of sorghum in the state for 1973, Agriculture Commissioner John C. White has announced.

Total production for the county was 22,677,000 bushels.

Statewide, some 2,355,000 irrigated and 5,745,000 unirrigated acres were planted in sorghum.

Other counties in the top five in all sorghum production include Lamb, Farmer, Hidalgo, and Swisher.
